

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
OPERATION OF THE EIGHTEENTH GUAM
LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand
3 Dollars (\$5,850,000), of which Six Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars
4 (\$630,000) is allocated to the Minority, is appropriated from the General
5 Fund to the Legislature Operations Fund for the continuing operation of the
6 Eighteenth Guam Legislature and for the Office of the Suruhanu. The
7 funds for the operation of the Office of the Suruhanu shall be allocated by
8 the Committee on Rules.

9 Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any
10 appropriation made to the Eighteenth Guam Legislature for use up until
11 September 30, 1985, as previously allocated by the Committee on Rules,
12 shall continue to be available until the end of Fiscal Year 1986.

13 Section 3. The sum of Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) is
14 appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislature Operations Fund for
15 the operation of the Eleventh Guam Youth Congress.

COMMITTEE REPORT
Bill No. 644 as Substituted

"An act making an appropriation for the operation
of the Eighteenth Guam Legislature"

The Committee on rules met at 1 p.m. Tuesday, September 24, 1985, in the Legislative Conference Room and discussed Bill No. 644 "An act making an appropriation for the operation of the Eighteenth Guam Legislature".

Committee members present were Senator John P. Aguon, Chairman, Speaker Carl T.C. Gutierrez; and Senators Don Parkinson, E. P. Arriola, H. D. Dierking, F. J. Gutierrez, F. J. Quitugua, F. R. Santos and E. R. Duenas. Senator P. C. Lujan was present for the latter portion of the meeting.

The Committee agreed to the following changes:

The introduction line was changed to read: Introduced by: Committee on Rules. Section 1 was altered to add language which sets aside Six Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$630,000) of the total budget for Minority operations.

A Section 3 was added to appropriate Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) for the operation of the Eleventh Guam Youth Congress.

There were no other changes in the bill.

Committee Findings

The Committee recommends that Bill No. 644 as substituted be passed.
