






An Act relating to an enacting clause
for laws and a resolving clause for
resolutions.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GUAM CONGRESS:

2 Section 1. Enacting clause for laws. The enacting clause of all
3 laws shall hereafter read, "Be it enacted by the People of the territory
4 of Guam".

5 Section 2. Resolving clause for resolutions. The resolving clause
6 of all resolutions shall read, "Be it resolved by the Legislature of the
7 territory of Guam".

8 Section 3. Public Law No. 13, Ninth Guam Congress, adopted prior
9 to the Organic Act of Guam is hereby declared repealed in its entirety.

10 Section 4. This act is an urgency measure and shall take effect
11 upon its approval by the Governor.
