


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





An Act to authorize and direct the Board of Education to study and report upon ways and means to make higher education available to the young men and women of Guam.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Board of Education is hereby authorized  
3 and directed to study various ways and means of making higher  
4 education available to the young men and women of Guam. Such  
5 study shall embrace; vocational courses, scholarships for  
6 collegiate training in existing institutions outside Guam, es-  
7 tablishment of a junior college, and other alternative educational  
8 and training programs, the relative costs, and the needs of the  
9 community for each. The Board is directed to report its recom-  
10 mendations to the Governor for transmission to the Congress by  
11 January 1, 1952.

12 Section 2. Services of government employees may be  
13 available, with the approval of the Governor, to assist the Board  
14 in this study.

15 Section 3. Effective date. This is an urgency measure and  
16 shall become effective upon the date of its approval by the Governor.
