



An Act repealing Section 178 of Chapter VII
of Title VII of Part I of the Penal Code of
Guam relating to engaging in trade by public
officials.

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Sec. 1. Section 178 of Chapter VII of Title VII of Part I
3 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby repealed in its entirety.
4 Sec. 2. This is an urgency measure and shall take effect
5 upon its approval by the Governor.
