

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



An Act amending section 634 of Chapter I of Title XV of Part I of the Penal Code of Guam relating to using explosives or poisonous substances in the taking of fish.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 634 of Chapter I of Title XV of Part I of  
3 the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:  
4 "It is prohibited to use any explosive substance or any poisonous  
5 substance, including the use of "putting", "chlorox" and similar sub-  
6 stance, in any of the waters in or about this Island for the purpose of  
7 taking fish. Any person violating this provision shall be punished by  
8 a fine of not less than fifty (\$50.00) dollars nor more than five  
9 hundred (\$500.00) dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than sixty  
10 days or by both such fine and imprisonment and for the second and sub-  
11 sequent convictions hereafter obtained under this Section the penalty  
12 therefor shall be imprisonment for a term not less than six (6) months  
13 and not more than two years.

14 Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall become effective  
15 upon its approval by the Governor.
