Sec. 2. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed twenty 1 2 per cent (20%) of any of the foregoing item or items of this appropriation to any other item or items of this appropriation, but no item of 3 4 appropriation shall be increased more than twenty per centum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such 5 6 transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature. Sec. 3. Any appropriations heretofore or herein made to carry out 7 a specific purpose, operation, project or function, except appropriations 8 for the normal operation of the Government of Guam, shall continue in 9 10 full force and effect and shall be available until expended for such purpose, operation, project or function. 11 12 Sec. 4. (a) The Governor may, when he deems it necessary and proper, create and establish a revolving fund or funds out of monies received in 13 14 connection with such activities of the Government of Guam as the purchase 15 and sale of seed by the Department of Agriculture, the purchase and sale 16 of books by the Department of Education, the purchase and sale of material and labor in aid of supplying utilities services by the Department of 17 18 Public Works and similar activities. 19 (b) Such revolving fund or funds, if and when created and established, 20 shall be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the Govern-21 ment of Guam, and independent records and accounts shall be maintained in 22 connection therewith as prescribed by the Director of Finance. 23 (c) All monies received from said activities shall be deposited in the 24 appropriate revolving fund or funds and all debts, liabilities, obligations

and operating expenses in connection with such activities shall be paid

(e) The Director of Finance shall periodically audit the accounts and records of such revolving fund or funds and render a report thereon to the Governor.

Sec. 5. The Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to expend out of the appropriation for the operation of the Government of Guam allotted to travel, dues and necessary travel expenses in connection with the Governor's attendance at the "Governors' Conference".

Sec. 6. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective upon upon approval by the Governor.
