## FIRST GUAM LEGISLATURE 1951 (FIRST) Regular Session

Bill No. 9

Public Law 18

An Act amending Section 81 of Title VI of Part I of the Penal Code of Guam relating to disturbing the Guam Legislature while in session.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Sec. 1. Section 81 of Title VI of Part I of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended to read: "Every person who willfully disturbs the Guam Legislature while in session, or who commits any disorderly conduct in the immediate view and presence of the Legislature tending to interrupt its proceedings or impair the respect due to its authority, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
