
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Sec. 1. Section 81 of Title VI of Part I of the Penal  
11 Code of Guam is hereby amended to read: "Every person who willfully  
12 disturbs the Guam Legislature while in session, or who commits any  
13 disorderly conduct in the immediate view and presence of the Legis-  
14 lature tending to interrupt its proceedings or impair the respect  
15 due to its authority, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
