
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



An Act to amend Section 11 of Public Law 4

employees of the Government of Guam.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Sec. 11 of Public Law 4 as enacted by the ~~Eleventh~~ <sup>FIRST GUAM LEGISLATURE,</sup>  
<sup>FIRST SPECIAL SESSION,</sup>  
Guam Congress is hereby amended to read:

"Sec. 11. Overseas Differential. In the event it is  
necessary or desirable to recruit officers or employees for  
the Government of Guam from the Continental United States or  
other territory of the United States, the Governor may, on  
all contracts executed after July 1, 1951, authorize an  
overseas pay differential of not to exceed twenty-five  
per cent of the base rate of pay established for the posi-  
tion or for the class by this Act. Such pay differential  
shall be in addition to allowances which may be provided  
for transportation of the employee, his dependents and his  
household and personal effects."
