| 20 | Section 2. The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed twenty |
| 21 | per cent (20%) of any of the foregoing items of this appropriation to any |
| 22 | other appropriation or appropriations, but no appropriation shall be increased |
| 23 | more than twenty per centum as a result of such transfer; provided, that |
| 24 | quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam |
| 25 | Legislature. |
| 26 | Section 3. The Governor is authorized and empowered, subject to legal |
| 27 | review by the Attorney General, to discharge by payment from any appropriated, |
| 28 | unencumbered and unexpired public funds, any valid liability in tort or in |
| 29 | contract, of the Government of Gugm. |
| 30 | Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure, and shall become effective |
| 31 | upon the date of its approval by the Governor. |
