Guerrero 3 (by request) 4 An Act delegating additional duties. functions and powers to the Board on 5 Utility Rates in Guam, to determine and recommend schedules of taxi rates, 6 and for other purposes. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 8 Section 1. The Board on Utility Rates in Guam created and established in accordance with the provisions of Public Law No. 1, FIRST 9 QUAM LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION, Eleventh Guam Congress, approved December 21, 1950, is hereby charged 10 11 with the following additional duties, functions and powers: 12 a. To formulate, establish, and publish, and from 13 time to time to review and where necessary to revise. 14 subject to the approval of the Governor, a fair and 15 reasonable schedule of taxi rates for all types of 16 taxicab fares. Such schedules may provide for a 17 schedule of rates by the mile, by the zone, or such 18 other method as the Board may deem appropriate and 19 desirable, as well as rates for a stand-by weiting 20 charge. 21 b. The Board shall annually, and may in its discretion 22 more often, upon complaint or upon its own motion, 23 review and recommend revision of such schedule of rates 24 as may at any time be in effect. 25 c. The Board shall fix and publish, subject to the 26 approval of the Governor, a comprehensive schedule 27 of taxi rates not later than ninety days after the 28 enactment of this Act. 29 d. The Board shall have the power to require the instal-30 lation of standard taxicab fare meters in all taxicabs 31 and may, upon appropriation being made therefore, purchase 32 said meters for resale in installments or rental to taxicab

	Section 2. The various departments of the Government of
	Guam shall furnish the Board all available information concerning any
	phase of the taxicab business in their possession upon request by the
	Chairman.
	Section 3. The Board is authorized to hold under such
	reasonable rules as it may adopt such open or closed hearings as it
	may deem necessary or desirable in order to afford interested indivi-
	duals, businesses, and corporations an opportunity to appear and
	present evidence having a bearing upon any of the taxi rates in effect
	or under consideration, and with the unanimous consent of its members
	the Board may subpoena witnesses, books, and records pertinent to its

14 Section 4. Every approved schedule of taxi rates or modi15 fication thereof shall become effective on the first day of the month
16 following the date of publication thereof.

17 Section 5. Every person who wilfully and knowingly charges, 18 receives, or contracts for, or who agrees or promises to charge or 19 receive any money or thing of value in excess of the legal taxi rates 20 established by the Board on Utility Rates for or in consideration of 21 any taxi service of whatever nature, shall, upon conviction, be guilty 22 of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$50,00 nor more 23 than \$500.00 or by imprisonment of not less than 30 days nor more than 24 six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

25 Section 6. This act shall become effective upon the date 26 of its approval by the Governor.
