
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



An Act to amend the Alcoholic Beverage Control  
Act.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 3301 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act  
as amended by Public Law No. 11, First Guam Legislature approved by the  
Governor May 9, 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"S 3301. Same: Non-citizens. Except in the case of an  
on-sale license for a premise under the operation or control  
of a person who is a contractor to the United States or of a  
bar tender's license, the board shall not issue a license to  
any person who is not a citizen or national of the United States  
having resided on Guam permanently and continuously for a period  
of at least two years immediately preceding the date of applica-  
tion for a license. If the person is a partnership, each  
partner must be such citizen or national of the United States,  
and if a corporation, a majority of the members of the board of  
directors must be such citizens or nationals of the United States,  
and all of the persons who are charged with the duties of managing  
or conducting the business must be citizens or nationals of the  
United States residing on Guam but need not possess a previous  
residence of particular duration. The board may issue an on-sale  
license for a premise under the operation or control of a person  
who is a contractor to the United States or a bartender's license  
to any citizen or national of the United States."
