
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. Sec. 15 of Public Law No. 34 is hereby amended

12 to read:

13 "Sec. 15. The hours of operation of cockpits shall be

14 as follows:

15 (a) Sundays, legal and/or church

16 holidays 0900 to 1830

17 (b) Saint's Feast Day of a village 1000 to 1830

18 (c) On other authorized days 1000 to 1830

19 (d) The Board, or if such board is not in existence the

20 Governor of Guam, may authorize the operation of

21 cockpits in connection with approved charitable

22 activities additional hours after 1830 but not

23 later than 2200."

24 Section 2. A new section to be numbered 19 is hereby added  
25 to Public Law No. 34 to read as follows:

26 "Sec. 19. Notwithstanding any of the provisions thereof

27 the board, or if such board is not in existence the Governor

28 of Guam may authorize the temporary operation of cockpits

29 in connection with approved charitable activities without

30 the awarding of licenses, posting of notices or the payment

31 of fees specified herein nor shall any other taxes be

32 collected for such operation."

Section 3. This is an urgency measure and shall take effect

upon approval by the Governor.
