Bill No. 122

Public Law 39

Introduced by Manuel F. L. Guerrero

An Act making an appropriation for the contingent expenses of the Guam Legislature, to take effect immediately.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for contingent expenses of the Guam Legislature to be allocated for the completion of the recodification of the laws of Guam.

Section 2. This act makes an appropriation for expenses of the Legislature, is an urgency measure, and shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Governor.
