



AN ACT

To amend Public Law 28, First Guam Legislature, First Regular Session.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam

Section 1. Sec. 3 of Public Law 28 enacted by the First Guam Legislature, First Regular Session is hereby repealed and a new section 3 is added to read:

“Sec. 3. Before adopting any schedule of taxi rates or any amendment thereof, the Board shall hold at least one public hearing thereon, notice of the time and place of which shall be given by at least one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam, at least ten days before the day of said hearing. With the unanimous consent of its members, the Board may subpoena witnesses, books and records pertinent to its duties.”

Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective upon approval by the Governor.
