

5 An Act to amend the Guam Civil Defense
6 Act of 1951.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law 21 as enacted by the First
9 Guam Legislature, First Regular Session, is hereby amended to read:

10 "Sec. 5. CIVIL DEFENSE ADVISORY COUNCIL - There is
11 hereby created a Civil Defense Advisory Council (herein-
12 after called the "Council"), consisting of fourteen members,
13 in addition to the chairman, appointed by the Governor as
14 follows: One member from the Department of Public Safety;
15 one member from the Guam Militia; one member from the
16 Department of Medical Services; one member shall be the
17 Chief Commissioner of Guam or his representative; one
18 member from the Department of Education; one member from
19 the Department of Agriculture and eight public minded
20 citizens from private business, welfare organizations or
21 civic associations on Guam. / In addition to the foregoing
22 fourteen members, the Governor is hereby authorized to
23 request from appropriate military authorities, the desig-
24 nation of two members from the Armed Forces of the United
25 States to provide liaison between the Armed Forces and the
26 government of Guam in Civil Defense activities. The Council
27 shall advise the Governor and the Director on matters pertain-
28 ing to civil defense. The Governor shall serve as Chairman
29 of the Council, and the members thereof shall serve without
30 compensation, but may be reimbursed for reasonable and
31 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their
32 duties as certified by the Treasurer of Guam.

Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall become effective upon the approval of the Governor.
