




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

7 Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law 1 enacted by the First
8 Guam Legislature, First Special Session is hereby repealed and a new
9 section 6 is added to read:

10 "Sec. 6. Before adopting any schedule of water rates,
11 or any amendment thereof, the Board shall hold at least
12 one public hearing thereon, notice of the time and place
13 of which shall be given by at least one publication in a
14 newspaper of general circulation in Guam, at least ten
15 days before the date of said hearing. The Board, with
16 the unanimous consent of its members, may subpoena
17 witnesses, books and records."

18 Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall become
19 effective upon approval by the Governor.
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
