



An Act to amend Public Law No. 3, First
Guam Legislature, First Special Session,
by adding thereto a provision imposing
a time limitation upon the filing of
claims against the Commercial Port of
Guam.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 10(c), Public Law No. 3, First Guam
Legislature, First Special Session, approved January 3, 1951, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"(c) All monies received by the Commercial
Port of Guam from whatever source derived shall be
deposited in said Commercial Port of Guam Fund. All
debts, liabilities and obligations, and operating
expenses of the said Commercial Port, including the
payment of any claims arising from its operation,
shall be paid from said Fund. The Director of
Commerce, or such other officer of the Government
as the Governor may designate, is hereby authorized,
subject to the legal review and approval of the
Attorney General of Guam, to settle and pay any and
all cargo and property damage claims arising out of
the operations of the Commercial Port of Guam; pro-
vided, however, that such claims must be presented
to the Commercial Port of Guam within one year
after the accrual thereof in order to be paid as
provided herein."
