An Act to amend Section 3850 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, relating to the control of alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 3850 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act is hereby amended to read:

"Sec. 3850. The board shall consist of five members who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Guam Legislature. The Governor shall designate one of the members chairman. Three members shall be appointed for a term expiring June 30, 1950 and the remaining two members for a term expiring June 30, 1951. Thereafter every appointment shall be made for a term of two years, commencing from the date of the expiration of the last preceding term."
