
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





An Act to amend Section 3850 of the
Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, relat-
ing to the control of alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 3850 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act
is hereby amended to read:

"Sec. 3850. The board shall consist of five members
who shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and
consent of the Guam Legislature. The Governor shall desig-
nate one of the members chairman. Three members shall be
appointed for a term expiring June 30, 1950 and the remain-
ing two members for a term expiring June 30, 1951. There-
after every appointment shall be made for a term of two
years, commencing from the date of the expiration of the
last preceding term."
