
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

4 An Act making supplemental appropriations  
5 for the operation of the government of  
6 Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
1952, and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of one  
9 million and five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) from any  
10 otherwise unappropriated funds in the Treasury of Guam for the  
11 development of public utilities in the territory of Guam. Of this  
12 sum, one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be available for  
13 planning and construction of generating facilities; provided, how-  
14 ever, that if adequate generating facilities can be planned and  
15 constructed for less than the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00),  
16 the remainder thereof shall be available for construction of trans-  
17 mission and distribution facilities. The remaining sum of five hundred  
18 thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be allocated to the utilities  
19 revolving fund, to be available for construction and maintenance of  
20 transmission and distribution facilities and for utility operating  
21 costs.

22 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of one  
23 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) from any otherwise  
24 unappropriated funds in the Treasury of Guam for the development of  
25 the distribution of water in rural areas in the territory of Guam.

26 Section 3. The following sums are appropriated out of  
27 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated for operation  
28 of the government of Guam for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952:

29 A. For the Department of Finance	\$12,000.00
30 B. For the Department of Medical	
31 Services	\$42,500.00
32 C. For the Immigration Service	\$ 2,900.00

D. For the Department of Education \$26,100.00

The Governor of Guam may transfer not to exceed twenty per cent (20%) of any of the foregoing items of this section to any other appropriation or appropriations, but no appropriation shall be increased more than twenty per centum as a result of such transfer; provided, that quarterly a statement of any such transfer shall be transmitted to the Guam Legislature.

Section 4. This is an urgency measure and shall become effective upon approval by the Governor.
