






7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

8 Section 1. The funds appropriated and allocated by
9 Public Law 37 are hereby re-allocated in the following particulars:

- 10 (a) From the funds allocated for personal services,
11 there shall be transferred the sum of \$3,571.30
12 to the allocation for other contractual services.
- 13 (b) From the funds allocated for transportation of
14 things, there shall be transferred the sum of
15 \$726.98 to the funds allocated for printing
16 and printing.
- 17 (c) From the funds allocated for equipment, there
18 shall be transferred the sum of \$1,200.00 to
19 the funds allocated for printing and binding.
- 20 (d) From the funds allocated for contingencies,
21 there shall be transferred the sum of \$3,000.00
22 to the funds allocated for travel.
- 23 (e) From the funds allocated to communication, there
24 shall be transferred the sum of \$360.04 to the
25 funds allocated for supplies and materials.

26 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure and shall take
27 effect upon its approval by the Governor.
