
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. The sum of Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred
11 Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$94,979.00), or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated for the contingent expenses of
13 the Judicial Branch, Government of Guam.

14 Section 2. Of the total sum of Ninety-Four Thousand Nine
15 Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$94,979.00), no more than Seventy-Three
16 Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars (\$73,859.00) should be spent
17 for subhead 01, personal services.

18 Section 3. It is provided that in the event that the estimated
19 total revenues for the fiscal year 1953 of the Government of Guam in
20 the amount of \$10,200,000.00 as submitted by the Department of Finance,
21 should be overstated or over-estimated as a result of a subsequent and
22 final judicial determination regarding the validity of the Territorial
23 Income Tax Laws, which have been included in the above estimates, an
24 over-all reduction of 10% on the total operational budget in the amount
25 of \$94,979.00 is hereby decreed to the allotments authorized by this
26 budget to the Judicial Branch, Government of Guam.

27 Section 4. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective
28 upon approval by the Governor.
