
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. The sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred
11 Forty-Eight Dollars (\$48,948.00), or so much thereof as may be
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated for the contingent expenses of
13 the Guam Legislature for the 1952 Regular Session, including expenses
14 of committees.

15 Section 2. Of the total sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine
16 Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$48,948.00), no more than Seventeen
17 Thousand Ninety-Three Dollars (\$17,093.00), should be spent for
18 subhead 01, personal services.

19 Section 3. It is provided that in the event that the
20 estimated total revenues for the fiscal year 1953 of the Government
21 of Guam in the amount of \$10,200,000.00 as submitted by the Depart-
22 ment of Finance, should be overstated or over-estimated as a result
23 of a subsequent and final judicial determination regarding the
24 validity of the Territorial Income Tax Laws, which have been included
25 in the above estimates, an over-all reduction of 10% on the total
26 operational budget in the amount of \$48,948.00 is hereby decreed to
27 the allotments authorized by this budget to the Guam Legislature.

28 Section 4. This act makes an appropriation for the usual
29 expense of the Legislature an urgency measure, and shall take effect
30 immediately upon its approval by the Governor.
