An Act making an appropriation for the contingent expenses of the Guam Legislature, including expenses of committees, to take effect immediately.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. The sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred 8 Forty-Eight Dollars (\$48,948.00), or so much the reof as may be 9 necessary, is hereby appropriated for the contingent expenses of 10 the Guam Legislature for the 1952 Regular Session, including expenses of committees. 12

13 Section 2. Of the total sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$48,948.00), no more than Seventeen 14 15 Thousand Ninety-Three Dollars (\$17,093.00), should be spent for 16 subhead Ol, personal services.

17 Section 3. It is provided that in the event that the 18 estimated total revenues for the fiscal year 1953 of the Government 19 of Guam in the amount of \$10,200,000.00 as submitted by the Department of Finance, should be overstated or over-estimated as a result 20 21 of a subsequent and final judicial determination regarding the 22 validity of the Territorial Income Tax Laws, which have been included 23 in the above estimates, an over-all reduction of 10% on the total 24 operational budget in the amount of \$48,948.00 is hereby decreed to 25 the allotments authorized by this budget to the Guam Legislature.

> Section 4. This act makes an appropriation for the usual expense of the Legislature an urgency measure, and shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Governor.
