Introduced by   
Antonio C. Cruz

An Act amending Sections 3150, 3602, 3702, 3714, repealing Section 3652, and adding Sections 3211, 3212, 3702.1 and 4151.1 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act relating to the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Sec. 3150 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act is hereby amended to read:

"S 3150. Licenses authorized. The board is authorized to issue the following classes and kinds of licenses at the following fees:

- Class 1. Manufacturer's license . . . . . \$100 per year
- Class 2. Agent's license . . . . . \$250 per year
- Class 3. Wholesale dealer's license . . . . . \$500 per year
- Class 4. Retail dealer's on-sale license: . . . . .
  - Beer . . . . . \$150 per year
  - General . . . . . \$500 per year
  - Wine . . . . . \$150 per year
- Class 5. Retail dealer's off-sale license:
  - Beer . . . . . \$ 50 per year
  - General . . . . . \$400 per year
- Class 6. Special alcohol license . . . . . \$ 25 per year
- Class 7. Temporary beer license . . . . . \$ 5 per day
- Class 8. Bartender's license . . . . . \$ 20 per year
- Class 9. Public warehouseman's license . . . . . \$ 25 per year
- Class 10. Club license . . . . . \$250 per year

Section 2. A new section to be numbered 3211 is hereby added to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act to read:

"S 3211. Club Licenses. A club license shall be general only and shall authorize the licensee to sell liquors to members of the club and

1 to guests thereof enjoying the privileges of membership, for consump-  
2 tion only on the premises kept and operated by such club, and shall  
3 also authorize any bona fide club member to keep in his private locker  
4 on such premises a reasonable quantity of liquor, if owned by himself,  
5 for his own personal use and not to be sold, and which may be consumed  
6 only on the premises."

7 Section 3. A new section to be numbered 3212 is hereby  
8 added to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act to read:

9 "S 3212. Special Conditions, Club Licenses. No liquor shall be  
10 sold under a club license to any person not a bona fide member of the  
11 club nor a bona fide guest thereof enjoying the privilege of membership,  
12 but a member or a guest enjoying the privileges of membership may pur-  
13 chase liquor for consumption on the premises by his own bona fide guests.  
14 No guest of a member or of a guest enjoying the privileges of member-  
15 ship shall purchase or be permitted to purchase liquor on the premises."

16 Section 4. Section 3602 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control  
17 Act is hereby amended to read:

18 "S 3602. Same: Exterior of on-sale premises. An on-sale licensee  
19 shall not place nor permit to be placed any sign upon or adjacent to the  
20 exterior of the premises which advertises any alcoholic beverage or  
21 which advertises or which uses the words bar, saloon or cocktail, either  
22 alone or in conjunction with other words or which uses any symbol having  
23 a similar import unless such sign shall first have been approved by the  
24 board."

25 Section 5. Sec. 3652 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act  
26 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

27 Section 6. Sec. 3702 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act  
28 is hereby amended to read:

29 "S 3702. Hours of Sale. On-sale premises. An on-sale licensee  
30 shall not sell, serve nor permit any person to consume any alcoholic  
31 beverages after 1:00 a. m., except that as to the day preceding New  
32 Year's Day, the closing time shall be 2:00 a. m. January 1st. A licensee



1           may begin selling or serving alcoholic beverages at 10:00 a. m.  
2 Monday through Saturday inclusive and at 11:00 a. m. Sunday."

3           Section 7. A new section to be numbered 3702.1 is hereby  
4 added to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act to read:

5           "S 3702.1. Any person who brings alcoholic beverages into a  
6 premise operated by an on-sale licensee and consumes the same thereon  
7 so as to cause a violation of Section 3702 of this act is guilty of a  
8 misdemeanor."

9           Section 8. Sec. 3714 of the Alcoholic Beverage Control  
10 Act is hereby amended to read:

11           "S 3714. Size of distilled spirits packages: A licensee shall  
12 not deliver to any on-sale licensee nor shall any on-sale licensee have  
13 in his possession distilled spirits in packages containing more than  
14 one gallon or less than one ounce."

15           Section 9. A new section to be numbered 4151.1 is hereby  
16 added to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Act to read:

17           "S 4151.1. Any person under the age of twenty-one years pur-  
18 chasing alcoholic beverages or in possession thereof shall be guilty  
19 of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a  
20 fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding three  
21 months or by both such fine and imprisonment."
