

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. The Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to erect,
12 remodel and develop housing and related facilities in the Camp Witek area
13 for the purpose of providing adequate permanent living quarters principally
14 for government of Guam school teachers and their dependents, which school
15 teachers have been recruited from without the territory of Guam.

16 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the
17 Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Eighty-two Thousand
18 Dollars (\$82,000.00) to accomplish the purposes as set forth in section 1
19 herein.

20 Section 3. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective
21 upon approval by the Governor.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. The Governor of Guam is hereby authorized to erect,
12 remodel and develop housing and related facilities in the Camp Witek area
13 for the purpose of providing adequate permanent living quarters principally
14 for government of Guam school teachers and their dependents, which school
15 teachers have been recruited from without the territory of Guam.

16 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the
17 Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Eighty-two Thousand
18 Dollars (\$82,000.00) to accomplish the purposes as set forth in section 1
19 herein.

20 Section 3. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective
21 upon approval by the Governor.
