CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from monies in
11 the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated such an amount, not
12 to exceed five hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000.00),
13 as will enable the Government of Guam to fulfill its obligation of
14 annual contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, pursuant to, and in the manner
16 prescribed by, section 20 of Public Law 26, First Guam Legislature,
17 First Regular Session, approved August 29, 1951.

18 Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective
19 upon approval by the Governor.
