An Act making appropriation to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund, in an amount not to exceed five hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000.00), pursuant to section 20 of Fublic Law 26, First Guam Legislature, First Regular Session, approved August 29, 1951.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from monies in the Treasury of Guam not otherwise appropriated such an amount, not to exceed five hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000.00), as will enable the Government of Guam to fulfill its obligation of annual contribution to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1953, pursuant to, and in the manner prescribed by, section 20 of Public Law 26, First Guam Legislature, First Regular Session, approved August 29, 1951.

Section 2. This is an urgency measure and shall be effective upon approval by the Governor.
