
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Sec. 19 of the Motor Vehicle Code of Guam is  
11 hereby amended to read:

12 "Sec. 19. (a) Except in the case of a motor vehicle  
13 operated with a gearshift mechanism attached to the steer-  
14 ing column, a person shall not drive a motor vehicle upon  
15 a highway with more than one person, or if at least one of  
16 the persons is under twelve years of age with more than  
17 two persons in addition to the driver occupying the front  
18 seat of the vehicle. For the purposes of this section,  
19 two front seats shall be construed as the front seat of  
20 the vehicle.

21 (b) In the case of a motor vehicle operated with  
22 a gearshift mechanism attached to the steering column, a  
23 person shall not drive such vehicle upon a highway with  
24 more than two persons, regardless of age, in addition to  
25 the driver occupying the front seat of the vehicle.

26 (c) It shall be unlawful for a person to operate  
27 a common carrier upon a highway unless such common carrier  
28 shall be equipped with a portable fire extinguisher of the  
29 type and size required for the particular class of carrier  
30 by the Director of the Department of Public Safety."
