

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

10 Section 1. Sec. 3 of Article II of Public Law 32, First
11 Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read:

12 "Sec. 3. There is hereby levied on all
13 property in Guam a yearly tax at the rate of one
14 per cent of the value of land and one-half per
15 cent of the value of improvements on land. Such
16 tax shall be assessed and collected in the manner
17 prescribed in this Act. All proceeds derived by
18 the Government under any provision of this Act
19 shall be deposited in the Treasury of Guam to
20 the credit of the general fund."

21 Section 2. A new section to be numbered 3a is hereby
22 added to Article II of Public Law 32, First Guam Legislature to
23 read:

24 "Sec. 3a. The term "improvements" as used
25 in Section 3 of this article shall be construed
26 to mean buildings and permanent structures on
27 land. It is hereby declared to be the legisla-
28 tive intention, by the adoption of this section,
29 to encourage the cultivation of farms, lands
30 suitable for farming, and the production of live-
31 stock and poultry or the products thereof."

32 Section 3. This is an urgency measure and shall take
effect upon approval by the Governor.
