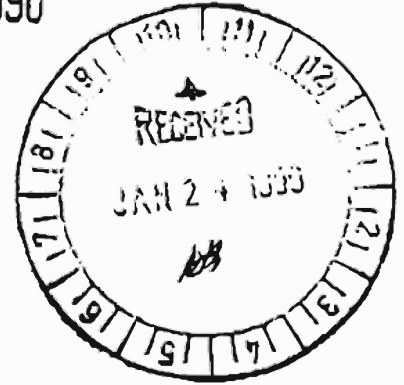





1 WHEREAS, the intersection of Route 4 and Maimai Road/Santa Cruz
2 Street has experienced a substantial number of accidents, many of which
3 have resulted in fatalities in recent years; and

4 WHEREAS, this intersection had been included in the Department of
5 Public Works FY '87 Highway Hazard Elimination Project recently awarded to
6 Hawaiian Rock Products; and

1 WHEREAS, this project consists of the widening of Route 4 to provide
2 for separate and protected turning storage lanes, but because of the limited
3 Federal-Aid Highway funds in FY '87, provision of a traffic signal was not
4 included; now, therefore

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

6 Section 1. The Department of Public Works is authorized to construct
7 a four-way traffic signal at the intersection of Route 4 and Maimai
8 Road/Santa Cruz Street and to repair the indentation in Route 4 close to
9 such intersection.

10 Section 2. One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$170,000) are
11 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to
12 implement Section 1 of this Act as follows:

14	Repair of indentation	<u>10,000</u>

INTERSECTION OF ROUTE 4 AND MAIMAI
ROAD/SANTA CRUZ STREET AND TO MAKE AN
APPROPRIATION**

The Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations held a joint public hearing on February 8, 1989, to gather testimony on Bill 70. Committee Chairs Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez and Senator Ted S. Nelson conducted the hearing, being joined by Senators E.P. Arriola, F.J.A. Quitugua, T.V.C. Tanaka, M.C. Ruth, J.G. Bamba, and E.R. Duenas.

ANALYSIS

Bill 70 would authorize the Department of Public Works to construct a traffic signal at the intersection of Route 4 and Maimai Road/Santa Cruz Street. This intersection was included in the Department of Public Works FY '87 Highway Hazard Elimination Project which was recently awarded to Hawaiian Rock Products. Because of the limited Federal-Aid Highway Funds in FY '87, a traffic signal was not included. The traffic signal at this intersection is necessary because a substantial number of accidents that have resulted in fatalities have occurred there in recent years.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS

The Committees find that the signal would greatly add to the safety of the intersection and that Rt. 4 is a major artery for traffic from southern and central Guam.

The Fiscal Note submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research does not comment on the sufficiency of the proposed \$160,000 to accomplish this purpose.

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations recommend that Bill 70 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Amended.
