


COMMITTEE REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON YOUTH, SENIOR CITIZENS, CULTURAL AFFAIRS AND HUMAN RESOURCES ON BILL NO. 694

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE REPAIR OF THE MERIZO SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.

PREFACE

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources held a public hearing in the Legislative Session Hall on September 18, 1989, to receive testimony on **Bill No. 694**. The hearing was conducted by Committee Chairperson, Senator Elizabeth P. Arriola and attended by Vice-Speaker Ted S. Nelson and Senators Pilar C. Lujan, Eddie D. Reyes, and Martha C. Ruth.

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Testifying orally was Mr. Ignacio "Buck" Cruz, Mayor of the Municipality of Merizo. Mayor Cruz testified favorably for Bill No. 694, and further stated that the Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) is not adequate to repair and extend the Senior Citizens Center. He requested that the funding be increased to include the following:

- 1. \$60,000 for the repair of the roof and extension of the center (28'x42')
- 2. \$2,000 for additional toilet facility
- 3. \$5,000 for the repair of the light fixtures and replacement of air conditioner
- 4. \$6,000 for installation of storage facility
- 5. \$4,000 for retaining wall
- 6. \$10,000 for extension of the Mayor's Office

When asked if the present facility is adequate to accomodate the Manamkos, Mayor Cruz replied that the present facility is considered inadequate in size because there are 22 to 30 Manamkos using the center daily.

The remaining witnesses, Mr. Juan C. Cruz, Mr. Joaquin B. San Nicolas, Ms. Ana C. Nanguata and Mrs. Rita R. Enalego all testified favorably expressing their views for the passage of Bill 694 to include the additional amount requested by Mayor Cruz.

FINDINGS

The Committee finds that the proposed improvement projects for the Merizo Senior Citizens Center are needed to provide the Manamkos with a more adequate and safe place to conduct their daily activities.





COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources, to which was referred *BIII NO. 694, "AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE REPAIR OF THE MERIZO SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER"*, has had the same under consideration, and now wishes to report back the same with the recommendation <u>TO DO PASS</u> as substituted by the Committee.
