The Committee on Ways & Means conducted a public hearing on Monday, November 6, 1989 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 1017. Senator Herminia D. Dierking, Acting Chairperson of the Committee conducted the hearing, being joined by Senator Martha C. Ruth.

TESTIMONY

Agana Mayor Felix Ungacta supported Bill No. 1017 indicating that the amount totaling \$18,000 was sufficient for the purchase of equipment. Mayor Ungacta also stated in his testimony that the passage of the proposed Bill "will definitely be an effective tool in the beautification program of Agana.

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research indicating that the amount specified on the proposed Bill is sufficient.

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 1017 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as amended.

(A WRITTEN TESTIMONY OF MAYOR FELIX F. UNGACTA IN FAVOR OF BILL NO. 1016 AND BILL NO. 1017).

MY NAME IS FELIX FLORES UNGACTA, BORN AND RAISED IN AGANA, GUAM AND PRESENTLY THE ELECTED MAYOR OF THE CITY OF AGANA FOR THE PAST THREE TERMS. I AM STRONGLY IN FAVOR IN THE PASSAGE OF BILL NO. 1016: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDRESSING THE FLOODING DAMAGES RESULTING FROM TROPICAL STORM COLLEEN.

THE PASSAGE OF BILL NO. 1017: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE EIGHTEEN THOUSAND (\$18,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGANA FOR THE PURCHASE OF STREET CLEANING EQUIPMENT: AS WELL AS THE PASSAGE OF BILL NO. 1016 WILL INDEED BE BENEFICIAL TO THE PEOPLE OF AGANA-ANIGUA.

THE APPROPRIATED FUNDS OF \$409,000 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGANA WILL HOPEFULLY CORRECT THE FLOODING PROBLEMS SPECIFIED IN THE BILL.


