COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS REPORT ON BILL NO. 1017

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGANA FOR THE PURCHASE OF STREET CLEANING EQUIPMENT.

The Committee on Ways & Means conducted a public hearing on Monday, November 6, 1989 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 1017. Senator Herminia D. Dierking, Acting Chairperson of the Committee conducted the hearing, being joined by Senator Martha C. Ruth.

TESTIMONY

Agana Mayor Felix Ungacta supported Bill No. 1017 indicating that the amount totaling \$18,000 was sufficient for the purchase of equipment. Mayor Ungacta also stated in his testimony that the passage of the proposed Bill "will definitely be an effective tool in the beautification program of Agana.

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research indicating that the amount specified on the proposed Bill is sufficient.

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 1017 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as amended.

I AM STRONGLY IN FAVOR IN THE PASSAGE OF BILL NO. 1016: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDRESSING THE FLOODING DAMAGES RESULTING FROM TROPICAL STORM COLLEEN.
