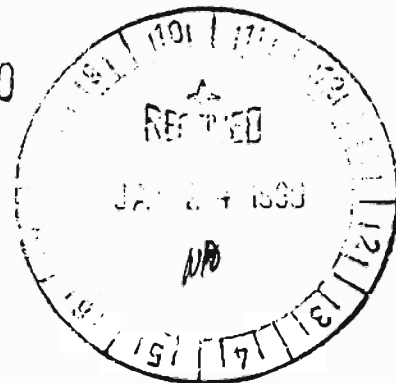



7 Section 2. Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) are hereby

9 Senior Citizens Center in Piti.

10 Section 3. Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) are hereby
11 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department to construct a
12 retaining wall, four feet in height and two hundred sixty-two linear feet in
13 length, along the bottom of the hillside between the Santa Rita Community
14 Center and J. P. Torres Elementary School.

15 Section 4. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are hereby
16 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department to construct a Youth
17 and Senior Citizens Center by extending the west end of the Santa Rita
18 Community Center an additional forty feet by sixty feet.

19 Section 5. Section 19 of Public Law 19-34 is hereby amended to read:

20 "Section 19. Community Center in Chalan Pago-Ordot. Five
21 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) are appropriated from the
22 General Fund to the Department of Public Works to construct a
23 community center for the municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot. Such
24 sums as are necessary for the operation of such community center are
25 hereby authorized to be appropriated from the General Fund to the
26 Department of Parks and Recreation."

1 Section 6. Section 2 of Public Law 19-42 is hereby amended to read:

**COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS
COMMITTEE REPORT**

**BILL NO. 1091 - AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE
SUM OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND
DOLLARS (\$125,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING
AND RENOVATION OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PITI.**

The Committee on Ways & Means conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, December 19, 1989 beginning at 9:00 a.m. in the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 1091. Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez, Chairman of the Committee conducted the hearing. Members present were Senators George M. Bamba, Franklin J.A. Quitugua, Doris F. Brooks and Martha C. Ruth.

TESTIMONY

Ms. Isabel Haggard, Mayor of Piti testified orally in support of Bill No. 1091. Also appearing before the Committee in support of the Bill were Mayors Raymond Laguana from Barrigada, Vicente L. San Nicolas from Asan-Maina, Buck Cruz from Merizo, Tito Mantanona from Talofofu, Nito Blas from Mangilao, John F. Blas from Yigo.

Mayor Greg Borja from Santa Rita and Chairman of the Finance and Legislative Committee of the Mayor's Council of Guam also appeared before the Committee in full support of the Bill. Mayor Borja asked the Committee to consider a request that he had made earlier when he testified for a Bill regarding his village (Attachment "A").

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research (Attachment "B").

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 1091 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Substituted.

TESTIMONY IN FAVOR OF BILL NO. 225

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE REPAIR AND
REPLACEMENT OF THE ROOFING AND LIGHTING SYSTEM
OF THE SANTA RITA COMMUNITY CENTER/COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE

Good morning Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee. I am here today to testify in support of Bill No. 225 (COR) An Act Making Appropriation For Improvements of the Santa Rita Community Center/Commissioner's Office.

As Commissioner of the District of Santa Rita-Sumay, I whole heartedly support the intent of Bill No. 225. The Santa Rita Municipal Planning Council unanimously endorsed the proposed Capital improvement projects for the Community of Santa Rita, during the regular monthly meeting on May 1, 1989.

I am appealing to the Committee to please consider the following amendments of the Bill, as follows:

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE ROOFING AND LIGHTING SYSTEM OF THE SANTA RITA COMMUNITY CENTER/COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, AND TO CONSTRUCT RETAINING WALL BETWEEN THE COMMUNITY CENTER AND J. P. TORRES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND TO EXTEND THE WEST END OF THE CENTER TO CONSTRUCT A MUTI-USE/JOINT USE YOUTH AND SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.

Section 1. The sum of EIGHTYEIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$88,000.) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of repairing and replacing the corrugated (Butler Type) sheetmetal roofing, steel purlings and insulation and the lighting electrical system of the Santa Rita Center/Commissioner's Office.

Section 2. The sum of TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works for the purpose of constructing retaining wall, four feet high by 262 linear feet along the bottom of the hillside between the Santa Rita Community Center and J. P. Torres Elementary School.


Section 3. The sum of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of constructing a YOUTH AND SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER, extending the west end of the Santa Rita Community Center, 40 feet by 60 feet. The Senior Citizens (MAN-AMKO) of Santa Rita are presently using the Santa Rita Public Health building, which is very inadequate in size, thereby limiting the number that can participate due to lack of space to accomodate them. Also, the Southern Region Public Health Division at Inarajan, plans to establish a satellite Health Center to serve the Communities of Agat, Santa Rita and Piti. The Health Center in Santa Rita is the best facility available among the three communities, and will have to be vacated so that Health Service may also be provided the community.

Section 4. That unencumbered amount from this appropriation shall be use for further improvements of the Santa Rita Community Center/ Commissioner's Office.

We plan to move the Senior Citizens to the Santa Rita Community Center as an interim location until we can provide them with a more convenient and safe place to conduct their daily activities. The youth of Santa Rita also does not have a place where they can conduct youth activities and secured place to store their equipments.

Thank you for the opportunity to testify before your Committee.

2 Section 1. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are
3 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
4 Public Works for the Architectural and Engineering design of a multi-
5 purpose building in Piti to house the Mayor's Office, youth center and
6 community center.

7 Section 2. Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) are hereby
8 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public
9 Works for the renovation of the Senior Citizens Center located in the
10 municipality of Piti.
