AN ACT APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR LOANS TO THE OPTION 3 CLAIMANTS IN THE GUAM LAND CLAIMS, AND AMENDING SECTION OF PUBLIC LAW 17 - 521 CONNECTION THEREWITH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) are hereby Section 1. appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Economic Development Authority (the "Authority") as interest free loans for the use of the Option 3 claimants in the Guam Land Claims cases filed pursuant to 48 U.S.C. Section 142(c).

Section 2. The Authority shall administer the appropriation made in Section 1 of the Act under the provisions of Public Law 17-52, and all loans made under this Act shall be repaid under terms and conditions consistent with Public Law 17-52.

Section 3. Section 2908 of Section 1 of Public Law 17-52 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection (h) thereto to read:

"(h) COLLECTABILITY OF LOANS. The collectability of the loans granted under the section is contingent upon the Option 3 Land Claimants receiving under their claims at least sufficient funds to repay their loans and attorney fees."

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Economic Development Authority for the purpose of a loan for the use and benefit of the Option 3 claimants in the Guam Land Claims cases filed pursuant to 48 U.S.C. Section 142 (c).

Section 2. The Guam Economic Development Authority shall administer this appropriation pursuant to the provisions of Public Law 17-52, and all funds loaned pursuant to this Section shall be repaid under terms and conditions consistent with Public Law 17-52.
