

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Substitute Bill No. 593 (LS), "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO BE DIVIDED EQUALLY AMONG THE MUNICIPAL PLANNING COUNCILS AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE MAYORS' COUNCIL, AND TO APPROPRIATE SIXTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND MANAGEMENT TO COMPENSATE NICOLAS D. AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO DIVIDED EQUALLY **AMONG** MUNICIPAL **PLANNING** COUNCILS AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE MAYORS' COUNCIL, AND TO APPROPRIATE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND MANAGEMENT TO COMPENSATE NICOLAS D. FRANCISCO FOR PROPERTY TAKEN BY THE GOVERNMENT.

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
- Section 1. Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$475,000)
- 3 are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Mayors' Council.

Section 2. The amount appropriated in Section 1 of this Act shall be distributed equally to all of the Municipal Planning Councils, with each municipality to receive Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for its use. Such funds may be used only (i) for expenses of the municipal mayor's office or for materials and equipment for such office, (ii) for the improvement or maintenance of public parks, restrooms, ball fields or other public facilities within the municipality, or (iii) for the temporary hiring of assistants for the municipal mayor's office.

Section 3. No funds appropriated by Section 1 of this Act may be expended without approval by resolution from the Municipal Planning Council of the municipality concerned and upon recommendation of its municipal mayor.

Section 4. Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Mayors' Council to be used as the Mayors' Council shall determine by resolution.

Section 5. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature to justly compensate those residents of Guam whose properties were taken from them by the government of Guam. Accordingly, Sixty Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$60,660) are hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Land Management to compensate Nicolas D. Francisco for that property taken by condemnation for public access and roadway uses by the government of Guam described as Lot No. 2358-3, Canada-Toto Loop, Barrigada, containing an area of 3,033 square meters.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$475,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE VILLAGE MUNICIPAL PLANNING COUNCILS, TO BE DIVIDED EQUALLY, AND TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) TO THE COMMISSIONER'S COUNCIL

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$475,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Commissioner's Council.

Section 2. The amount appropriated in Section 1 of this Act shall be distributed equally to all of the Municipal Planning Councils, with each village to receive \$25,000.00 for its use and benefit. The funds may be used only for expenses of the Commissioner's office or for materials and equipment for the Commissioner's office, for the improvement or maintenance of public parks, restrooms, ball fields or other public facilities within the village, or for the temporary hire of assistants in the Commissioner's office.

Section 3. No amounts appropriated by Section 1 of this Act may be expended without express approval by resolution from the Municipal Planing Council of the village concerned upon recommendation of the village's Commissioner.

Section 4. The sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Commissioner's Council to be used as the commissioner's council shall determine by resolution.
