



**COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS  
REPORT ON BILL NO. 302**

**BILL NO. 302: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING  
ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND  
DOLLARS TO INSTALL A SEWER LINE IN  
MAITE.**

A public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Ways & Means on Thursday, May 11, 1989, beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 302. Committee Chairman, Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez was joined by Senator Ted S. Nelson.

**TESTIMONY**

No witnesses came forward to testify, however, written testimony was received from the Speaker of the Twentieth Guam Legislature, Senator Joe T. San Agustin in full support and urged the Committee to act favorable on Bill No. 302 (see Exhibit A). Speaker San Agustin in his testimony, stated that the sewer line would be installed in the area behind the Hotel Plumeria in Maite which is an isolated pocket and does not have a sewer line at present. It would provide for 1100 feet of 8-inch pipe with manholes.

Mr. Anthony C. Blaz, Chief Officer, Public Utility Agency of Guam submitted written testimony in full support of Bill No. 302 (see Exhibit B).

**ANALYSIS**

The appropriation of \$118,000 will be sufficient for the installation of a sewer line behind the Hotel Plumeria in Maite based on a letter received by Speaker San Agustin from Anthony Blaz, Chief Officer of PUAG.

**RECOMMENDATON**

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 302 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.


As you are aware, water and sewer improvements are a major priority of this government. In response to concerns conveyed to me by constituents in Sinajana and Maite, I have sponsored Bill Nos. 312 and 302. Both these bills were originally introduced in the 19th Legislature as Bill Nos. 1104 and 1103 respectively. Unfortunately, they were not acted on. These bills provide for the installation of sewer lines in these communities.

Bill No. 312 appropriates \$884,000 for a sewer lines in the area around Agana Spring and Afame, Sinajana. Bill No. 302 appropriates \$118,000 for sewer lines in the area behind the Hotel Plumeria in Maite. This will provide 1100 feet of sewer lines with manholes. Both of the areas addressed in Bill Nos. 312 and 302 are isolated pockets which do not have sewer lines at present.

The estimated cost for both projects is based on a letter, dated Nov. 18, 1988, received from Anthony Blas, Chief Officer of PUAG (see attachment).

I am sure your Committee shares my concern for the needs of these communities. I am therefore hopeful for your favorable consideration of both bills.

Dear Senator San Agustin:

This is in reply to your letter dated October 28, 1988 requesting status of sewer projects in the following areas:

1. Maite, behind Hotel Plumeria:

There is no plans to install a sewerline in this area. However, the estimated cost for a sewerline is \$118,000 for 1100 feet of 8-inch pipe with manholes.

2. Afame: Behind Old Coca Cola Building and behind Ada's Funeral Home:

There is no plans at this time to install a sewerline in this area. The installation of a sewerline in this area would have been included in a sewer project for the entire remaining Afame area funded by P.L. 16-120 which appropriated \$150,000 and took effect on December 18, 1982. However, before a consultant agreement for the design of the project would had been sent out for approval, Public Law 18-1 was enacted on February 14, 1988 which reverted the appropriation to the general fund.

This remaining unserved area of Afame is included in a project to provide sewer around Agana Spring and the estimated cost is \$884,000.

3. Maina:

In the priority rating of sewer projects approved by Guam-EPA and US-EPA the Maina Sewer Collector is number four in the list. The project will involves the design and construction of 19,500 feet of pipeline with two (2) pump station and the estimated cost is \$1,713,000.





4. Barrigada Village - Layang:

This project: Layang - South Barrigada collectors is number six (6) in the priority listings for sewer projects. It will involve 46,000 but if sewerlines with one (1) pump station and seven (7) ejector station at an estimated cost of \$3,430,000.

We hope these information will meet your requirement. Should you need additional information, please let us know.



Good morning, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislative Committee on Ways & Means. I am here today to testify on Bill 302(COR) - An Act Appropriating \$118,000 to Install a Sewer Line in Maite.

The area behind the Hotel Plumeria is a moderately dense residential area with no public sewage collection system. Sewage from these residences are being collected through individualized septic tank/leachfields. Like many other septic tank/leachfields in other residential homes throughout Guam, these individualized sewer systems may not be properly maintained and may not be operating at a desirable level. The installation of sewer lines and appurtenances will provide a reliable public sewage system that would eliminate overflows and improper treatment of raw sewage from these septic tanks. As a result, risk of exposure to health and environmental hazards will be minimized if not totally eliminated.

The passage of this legislation will not only improve the health and environmental conditions of the project area, but will also generate additional revenue for PUAG through expanded sewer services.

PUAG encourages your passage of Bill 302(COR).

COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 302(COR)

Bill No. 302(COR) proposes to appropriate the sum of One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$118,000) to the Public Utility Agency of Guam to cover the cost of installing sewer lines and appurtenances in the Hotel Plumeria area of Maite. Funding source for the appropriation will be the General Fund.

Information received from the Chief Engineer of PUAG revealed that this was an on-site estimated project prepared by the agency. The estimated cost of the project is One Hundred Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$118,000).

The following is a breakdown of the estimated cost of the project.

Construction Cost	\$ 92,000
Design Cost	15,500
Contingency Cost	<u>10,000</u>
Total	\$118,000

Based on the above information, the amount being appropriated would be adequate to cover the cost of the proposed project.
