





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR A FOOTBALL PROGRAM, TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES THEREFOR, FOR DISC GOLF COURSES, FOR THE ELECTION COMMISSION, FOR A MOCK TRIAL TOURNAMENT, FOR GUMA MAMI, FOR A BASKETBALL TRIP, FOR A LEASE FOR GUMA MAMI, RELATING TO EMPLOYEES AT GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, TO WEST ACRES SUBDIVISION, AND TO A MASTER PLAN FOR RECREATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) are hereby appropriated  
3 from the General Fund to the University of Guam to implement a football  
4 program and for the purchase of equipment and supplies therefor.

5 Section 2. Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) are hereby appropriated  
6 from the General Fund to the Department of Parks and Recreation (the  
7 "Department") to design, procure and construct two (2) Disc Golf courses. The  
8 Department shall identify government of Guam land, parks, or recreation  
9 areas for the installation of such two (2) Disc Golf courses. One (1) such Disc  
10 Golf course should be installed for the immediate recreation needs of Guam's  
11 residents, and one (1) which will best meet the long term recreation needs of  
12 the island. The Department should consult and work with the Guam Frisbee  
13 Club in the implementation of this Section 2 of this Act.

14 Section 3. Section 9 of Public Law 20-132 is hereby amended to read:

15 "Section 9. Effective October 1, 1989, §4102 of Title 4, Guam Code  
16 Annotated, is amended by adding a new subsection (16) to read as

3 Public Health and Social Services (the "Department") for the expansion  
4 of residential and support services provided to the Department by

23 to pay lease payments up to September 30, 1990, in accordance with the  
24 lease agreement executed on January 2, 1986, between Guma Mami, Inc. and  
25 John Joseph Cruz, Sr. for the lease of that certain dwelling situated on Lot  
26 131-3, Toto, Guam, and in which Guma Mami, Inc. is now situated.

27 Section 10. Because of the high number of part-time employees at  
28 Guam Memorial Hospital, the restrictions on full-time equivalent employees  
29 ("FTEs") set out in Section 3 of Chapter XII of Public Law 19-10 shall not be  
30 applicable to health professionals employed by the Guam Memorial Hospital  
31 Authority.

32 Section 11. Item 3 of Section 4 of Public Law 19-52, as amended by  
33 Section 1 of Public Law 20-129, is further amended to read:

5 Section 12. The Department of Parks and Recreation shall prepare a  
6 master plan for islandwide recreational programs and facilities which shall be  
7 submitted to the Legislature no later than December 31, 1990 for its  
8 consideration and action thereon.

## **TESTIMONY**

Mr. Robert Underwood, a professor at the University of Guam, appeared before the Committee in behalf of the President of the Board of Regents of the University of Guam, Jesus U. Torres, who submitted written testimony in favor of the Bill. President Torres stressed the fact that the University of Guam has been without a football program for the past nine (9) years. The Guam Varsity Football Association has been formed comprised of local talent and will be sponsoring a league that will begin this summer. The University of Guam has formed a Football Club with young men anxious and excited to play football for the University of Guam. When questioned by Chairperson Dierking if \$50,000 was an adequate amount for the initial formation of such a football team at the University, both Professor Underwood and Robert Pelkey, the athletic director for the University of Guam, orally testified that it was. Chairperson Dierking, who indicated that she was a football enthusiast, and Speaker Joe T. San Agustin had no objection to the appropriation of the sum of \$50,000 to such a worthy cause.

## **RECOMMENDATION**



Dear Senator Gutierrez:

I am writing to provide testimony on Bill No. 1366 "An Act to Appropriate the Sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) from the general fund to the University of Guam for the implementation of a football program and to purchase equipment and supplies.

It has been nine (9) years now since the island of Guam has had a postsecondary football league. After the University of Guam Triton's Football team captured its fifth (5th) consecutive championship in the Varsity Football league sponsored by ComNavMar Recreation, it was dropped by the Navy citing "loss of man hours due to injuries and cost of running the program is exorbitant."

The Guam Varsity Football Association has been formed and will be sponsoring a league that will begin this summer composed of at least four (4) teams made up of local residents. I am happy to report that a Football Club has been formed at the University with about 50 student members. These young men are anxious and excited to play football for the University of Guam. We expect this enthusiasm to improve the morale and participation of our student body, especially since football is a popular spectator sport.

We also expect this enthusiasm to extend to the whole island community since there are many football



fans thirsting for football as indicated by the Exhibition Games that were played earlier this year with approximately 1500 plus fans attending the games.

Besides being popular, football is also a very expensive sport that require quality equipment and supplies to ensure the safety of all participants. Also needed will be some professionals to guide the players in the development of skills and sportsmanship. Consequently, the funds we are requesting will be used to purchase the essential equipment and supplies needed to operate a safe and healthy football program at the University of Guam.

We respectfully request that you approve Bill No. 1366. It is an important step towards providing another opportunity to our students and our island community.
