1 WHEREAS, the instructional, research and administrative facilities of the
2 University of Guam need to be upgraded immediately; and

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of the University of Guam has approved
2 a Physical Master Plan designed to provide facilities that will be conducive to
3 the learning process; and

4 WHEREAS, Public Law 20-41 appropriated Four Million Eight Hundred
5 Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) for the Phase I of the Physical Master Plan of
6 the University; and

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature intends that the approved Physical Master
8 Plan be funded, insofar as practicable, out of revenues for the next five (5)
9 fiscal years since the government of Guam is currently enjoying substantially
10 increased revenues from the current economic boom, and the Legislature
11 believes that the new money can best be spent on providing post-secondary
12 educational facilities for Guam's people; now, therefore,

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

14 Section 1. Appropriation. Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars
15 (\$4,800,000) are hereby appropriated from the Fiscal Year 1991 revenues of
16 the General Fund to the University of Guam (the "University") to implement
17 the Physical Master Plan approved by the University's Board of Regents (the
18 "Master Plan").

19 Section 2. Authorization for 1992. Four Million Eight Hundred
20 Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) are hereby authorized to be appropriated from
21 the Fiscal Year 1992 revenues of the General Fund to the University for the
22 continued implementation of the Master Plan.

23 Section 3. Authorization for 1993. Four Million Eight Hundred
24 Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) are hereby authorized to be appropriated from
25 the Fiscal Year 1993 revenues of the General Fund to the University for the
26 continued implementation of the Master Plan.

27 Section 4. Authorization for 1994. Four Million Eight Hundred
28 Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) are hereby authorized to be appropriated from
29 the Fiscal Year 1994 revenues of the General Fund to the University for the
30 continued implementation of the Master Plan.

31 Section 5. Authorization for 1995. Four Million Eight Hundred
32 Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) are hereby authorized to be appropriated from
33 the Fiscal Year 1995 revenues of the General Fund to the University for the
34 continued implementation of the Master Plan.





**COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS

BILL NO. 1201: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,800,000) FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991 TO THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PHYSICAL MASTER PLAN AS APPROVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM'S BOARD OF REGENTS.

The Committee on Ways & Means held a public hearing on Thursday, March 29, 1990 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Conference Room to gather testimony on Bill No. 1201. Senator Ted S. Nelson conducted the hearing, being joined by Senators J. George M. Bamba, Martha C. Ruth and Doris F. Brooks.

TESTIMONY

Mr. Jesus U. Torres, Chairman, Board of Regents submitted written testimony in full support of Bill No. 1201. Chairman Torres indicated that the plan, as approved, is designed to provide for not only a faculty that will enhance the learning process but also one that should instill pride in all of our island residents. He also indicated that the foresightedness in providing for continuing appropriation for FY 1992 through 1995 gives credence to the understanding of the need for completion of the planning process necessary for orderly development.

Senator Bamba inquired, why the University is taking a position of appropriating from the general fund in lieu of a tuition increase when the tuition revenues is one of the funding sources for the Physical Master Plan. He also inquired, if it would negatively affect their ability to go out to the private sector to raise the funds they need? In response to Senator Bamba's inquires, President Leon Guerrero said "no, I don't think so. I think what is needed in order for us to ensure that we actually implement the Physical Master Plan is some source of stable funding so that we can proceed and plan effectively.

Senator Bamba stated that, "going the route of subsidy, to him it would appear that it would weaken the University's position in seeking

private funds." President Leon Guerrero, "not at all, because I think in talking to prospective donors, one of the things they usually ask is what kind of support and what kind of commitment do you have from the local community and if you give the assurance that the government is, out of this \$54 million, is providing \$25 million and tuition is going to be based on such and such amount, it shows that there is effort and support being made not just by the prospective donors but even the commitment from the government." Senator Bamba then, congratulated the University because they are the only autonomous agency that has come in and said that subsidies are okay.

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research.

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 1201 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Substituted.



Comments on Bill No. 1201

Bill No. 1201 is an Act to appropriate the sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) from the General Fund for Fiscal Year 1991 to the University of Guam (UOG) for implementation of the Physical Master Plan as approved by the University's Board of Regents.


Section 1 of Bill 1201 appropriates from the General Fund for Fiscal Year 1991 the sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) to the UOG for implementation of the Physical Master Plan as approved by the University's Board of Regents.

Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 provides authorizations for the appropriation of Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,800,000) from the General Fund for four (4) consecutive fiscal years beginning with Fiscal Year 1992 and ending with Fiscal Year 1995 to the UOG for the continued implementation of the Physical Master Plan as approved by the University's Board of Regents.

Should Bill 1201 be enacted into law, a fiscal impact of \$4,800,000 on the General Fund is anticipated in Fiscal Year 1991. It should be noted that to date there are presently \$10,197,925 worth of appropriations to be charged to revenues in Fiscal Year 1991. Enactment of Bill 1201 would only increase the Fiscal Year 1991 General Fund Appropriation level from \$10,197,925 to \$14,997,925. Additionally, Public Law 20-41 appropriated \$4,800,000 from the General Fund to the UOG for the expansion, construction and renovation of the Micronesian Area Research Center, Library and Computer Center.

In reference to Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7, no impact on the General Fund

is anticipated at this time since the aforementioned sections are merely authorizations and not outright appropriations.




