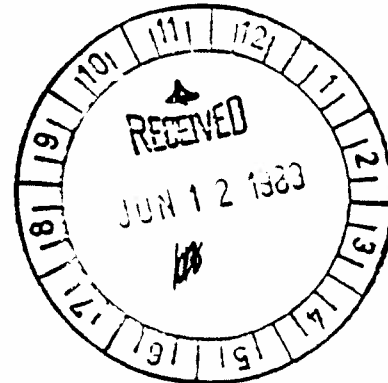





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$170,000) FOR AN OPEN CULVERT AT FINILE, FINILE SUB-DIVISION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The Department of Public Works is authorized to construct
3 an open culvert at Finile Drive, Finile Sub-Division, Agat.

4 Section 2. One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$170,000) are
5 hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public
6 Works to implement Section 1 of this Act.

7 Section 3. The Agat Municipal Planning Council shall supervise the
8 construction of the open culvert project at Finile Drive, Finile Subdivision
9 authorized by this Act and shall coordinate with the Department of Public
10 Works in its implementation. The contracting officer shall be the Director
11 of the Department of Public Works.

1 Section 4. Two Million Four Hundred Forty-Six Thousand Three
2 Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars (\$2,446,364) are hereby appropriated from the
3 General Fund of the Government of Guam to the University of Guam for the
4 Student Financial Assistance Fund established under §15103, Title 17, Guam
5 Code Annotated, and administered by the Board of Regents of the
6 University of Guam. The appropriations made under this Act shall be for
7 the period commencing August 1, 1989 and ending July 31, 1990, and shall
8 not be subject to any allotment reserve that could be imposed by the
9 Bureau of Budget and Management Research. The appropriation shall be
10 expended as follows:

11	(a) Professional/Technical Awards	\$545,822
12	(b) Student Loans	886,986
13	(c) Merit Awards (Guam	491,134

17 Section 5. (a). Pursuant to Section 15103, Title 17, Guam Code
18 Annotated, the appropriation made under Section 4 of this Act shall
19 supplement the unexpended balance of Three Hundred Forty Thousand Eight
20 Hundred Ten Dollars (\$340,810) in the Student Financial Assistance Fund,
21 including repayments to the Fund.

22 Section 5. (b). Two Hundred Ten Thousand Six Hundred
23 Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$210,657) are hereby appropriated from the General
24 Fund of the Government of Guam for the Teacher Training Scholarship
25 Program and the Nurses Training Program at the University of Guam
26 established under §§18102 and 19102, respectively, of Title 17, Guam Code
27 Annotated to be expended as follows:

28	(a) Teacher Training Scholarship Program	\$128,745
29	(b) Nurses Training Program	81,812

30 Section 7. (c). Pursuant to Section 15103, Title 17, Guam Code
31 Annotated, the appropriation made under §6 of this Act shall supplement
32 the unexpended balance of Two Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Forty Six
33 Dollars (\$258,046) in the Teacher Training Scholarship Program and the
34 Nurses' Training Program Fund, including repayments to the Fund.

1 Section 8. (d). Forty-Two Thousand Twenty-Four Dollars (\$42,024)
2 are hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Government of Guam
3 to the University of Guam to fund the Board of Regents ROTC Program
4 which provides all recipients with free tuition, books and fees and \$100 per
5 month for nine months per year for four years.

6 Section 9. (e). Sixty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Six
7 Dollars (\$69,886) are hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
8 Government of Guam for the operational budget of the University of Guam
9 Student Financial Assistance Program.

10 Section 10. Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000) are hereby
11 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Parks and
12 Recreation to make necessary repairs to the Agana Swimming Pool to
13 prepare it for the training camp to be held by the U. S. National Swimming
14 Team in August of 1989.

**BILL NO. 559: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE
THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND
DOLLARS (\$200,000) FOR AN OPEN
CULVERT AT FINILE, FINILE
SUBDIVISION.**

A joint public hearing was held by the Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations on Friday, May 5, 1989 to gather testimony on Bill No. 459. Committee Chairs Carl T.C. Gutierrez and Ted S. Nelson conducted by the hearing, being joined by Senators E. P. Arriola, F. J.A. Quitugua, J. G. Bamba, and D. F. Brooks.

BACKGROUND

Bill No. 559 proposes to fund the construction of a culvert to channel flood water from the hills above Finile to the ocean.

TESTIMONY

Commissioner Antonio Babauta testified about the work done so far to alleviate flooding in this area and how the appropriation in this measure could continue the project (see Attachment A). There are sixty-two families living in this area and they need the protection the culvert would give.

Assistant Commissioner John Quidachay testified in favor of Bill No. 559, citing the experience with flooding on April 28th of this year (see Attachment B).

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research indicating that the amount proposed will be sufficient for design and construction of the project which should cost \$170,000 (see Attachment C).


RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 559 by passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Amended.



GOOD MORNING MR. CHAIRMAN AND SENATORS.....MY NAME IS ANTONIO C. BABAUTA, COMMISSIONER OF AGAT, AND IN BEHALF OF THE PEOPLE OF AGAT, I AM HERE TO TESTIFY IN SUPPORT OF BILL 559, 575, 442, AND 593.

THE \$200,000.00 IN THIS BILL #559 SHOULD BE ENOUGH TO COVER THE A & E, AND THE PHASE ONE CONSTRUCTION OF AN OPEN CULVERT AT FINILE DRIVE, FINILE SUB-DIVISION IN AGAT.

FOUR (4) YEARS AGO, AN ASSESSMENT OFFICER FROM DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS ESTIMATED \$300,000.00 FROM ROUTE 2 TO THE END OF FINILE DRIVE (1,700 FEET). HOWEVER, SINCE THAT TIME, WE HAVE INSTALLED AN ENCLOSED CULVERT ABOUT 200 FEET LONG FROM FINILE DRIVE TO GAAN RIVER FOR \$25,000.00, THANKS TO SENATOR NELSON AND GOVERNOR BORDALLO, AND WE HAVE ALSO WIDEN THE DRAINAGE DITCH WITH THE MUNICIPAL FUNDS YOU PROVIDED US ANNUALLY. I FEEL THE \$200,000.00 REQUEST IS ENOUGH TO CONTINUE THIS PROJECT REALISTICALLY AND SINCE IT IS NOT TOO HIGH THE GOVERNOR MIGHT JUST RELEASE THE FUNDS, IF THIS APPROPRIATION BECOMES LAW. MR. CHAIRMAN AND SENATORS, THE PEOPLE IN FINILE NEEDS YOUR HELP IN CHANNELLING THE FLOOD WATER FROM THE HILLS, TO FINILE TO THE OCEAN. THE OPEN CULVERT SHOULD HAVE BEEN DONE YEARS AGO, HOWEVER IT IS NOT TOO LATE FOR US TO RECTIFY THE FLOODING PROBLEMS IN AGAT. MR. CHAIRMAN, SIXTY-TWO (62) FAMILIES AND I HAVE FAITH IN YOU AND YOUR COMMITTEE, AND WE ARE HOPING THAT YOUR CONSIDERATION WILL BE

POSITIVE TO THE PEOPLE OF AGAT'S REQUEST FOR A CLEANER AND DRYER STREET DURING THE RAINY SEASON.

TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF BILL # 575

THIS APPROPRIATION IS URGENTLY NEEDED TO ENSURE SAFETY AND CONTINUITY IN OUR SPORTS PROGRAMS. MR. HYUN IS THE ONLY PERSON ON GUAM WHO RESURFACES BASKETBALL AND TENNIS COURTS AND HE HAS JACKED UP HIS PRICE ACCORDING TO A CONTRACTING ENGINEER AT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS. 

5 (\$170,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department
6 of Public Works to implement Section 1 of this Act.
