**COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS
REPORT ON BILL NO. 226**

BILL NO. 226: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FORTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF THE PLAYING SURFACE, BACKBOARDS, BLEACHERS AND LIGHTING SYSTEM OF THE SANTA RITA BASKETBALL COURT.

A public hearing was held by the Committee on Ways & Means on Friday, May 5, 1989 beginning at 9:00 a.m. to gather testimony on Bill No. 226. Committee Chairman, Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez was joined by Senators F. J. A. Quitugua, E. P. Arriola, J. G. Bamba, and D. F. Brooks.

BACKGROUND

Bill No. 226 proposes to fund repairs for the Santa Rita Basketball Court.

TESTIMONY

Commissioner Gregorio Borja testified that this is a much needed sports facility for the 1,800 residents in the vicinity of the court (see Attachment A). He recommended that the amount be increased to \$65,000 to allow for the construction of new bleachers instead of trying to repair the old, unsafe ones.

Director of Parks and Recreation, Anthony Mariano, supported Bill No. 226, but urged that the project be done correctly with the court having the proper slope, increased playing surface, modification of the lighting system and new fencing where needed (see Attachment B). He stated that there are restroom facilities available. He asked that the Bill be amended so that the appropriation is made to the Department of Public Works which has the necessary contracting authority.

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research indicating that the amount necessary for the

project is \$55,000, and that the Bill should be amended accordingly (see Attachment C).

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill No. 226 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Amended.

A joint public hearing was held by the Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on Youth, Human Resources, Cultural Affairs, and Senior Citizens on Friday, May 5, 1989 to gather testimony on Bill 226. Committee Chairs Carl T. C. Gutierrez and Elizabeth P. Arriola conducted the hearing, being joined by Senators F.J.A. Quitugua, J.G. Bamba, and D.F. Brooks.

BACKGROUND

Bill 226 proposes to fund repairs for the Santa Rita basketball court.

TESTIMONY

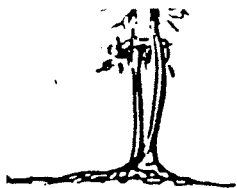
Commissioner Gregorio Borja testified that this is a much needed sports facility for the 1,800 residents in the vicinity of the court. (see Attachment A) He recommended that the amount be increased to \$65,000 to allow for the construction of new bleachers instead of trying to repair the old, unsafe ones.

Director of Parks and Recreation, Anthony Mariano, supported Bill 226, but urged that the project be done correctly with the court having the proper slope, increased playing surface, modification of the lighting system and new fencing where needed. (see Attachment B). He stated that there are restroom facilities available. He asked that the Bill be amended so that the appropriation is made to the Department of Public Works which has the necessary contracting authority.

A Fiscal Note was submitted by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research indicating that the amount necessary for the project is \$55,000, and that the Bill should be amended accordingly. (see Attachment C)

The Committee on Ways & Means recommends that Bill 225 be passed as amended by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.


Good Mr. Chairman and members of the Committee. As Commissioner of the District of Santa Rita-Sumay, I am here to testify in favor of Bill No. 226.

Dear Senator Gutierrez:

I am here to testify on Bill No. 226 that has been previously submitted to Senator Elizabeth Arriola, Chairperson, Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources.

The Santa Rita basketball court is a facility that is in definite need of repair and upgrading. The court has a definite advantage in that it is located directly within the village, is adjacent to the Santa Rita ball field and is also adjacent to a restroom. All of these conditions make the Santa Rita recreational area one of centralized value.

It is important that the restoration of the multi-purpose court be complete. Patchwork and resurfacing will not do the job. It is important that the project include the creation of a one percent slope on the new court surface, the installation of new fencing where needed and increased playing surface and modification of the lighting system

Recreational facility repair funds, if allocated and planned properly, is definitely a wise investment. However I must repeat, the planning must be proper.

Bill No. 226 is a good bill for the upgrading of a functional facility that will play an important part in the further use of the Santa Rita recreational area.

To expedite movement on this appropriation, it should be made directly to Department of Public Works and not Department of Parks and Recreation, As Department of Parks and Recreation does not have contracting authority.

Preface

A public hearing on Bill No. 226 (COR), was held by the Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs & Human Resources on Thursday, March 2, 1989 at the Legislative Session Hall.

Present at the hearing were the Chairperson Senator Elizabeth P. Arriola, and Committee Members Senators Gordon Mailloux, Edward Duenas, J. George Bamba, and Martha Ruth.

Background

The Santa Rita Basketball court is in dire need of repair and upgrading. The court has not been used for several years. Thus, youth activities requiring the use of the facility have somewhat been limited because of the unplayable condition of the court. Bill No. 226 (COR) will appropriate funding for the repair and upgrading of the facility.

Testimonies

Three people testified, all of whom were in support of the bill. See Attached written testimonies.

The Department of Parks and Recreation also recommended that the project should include a sloping on the court surface installation of fencing, and enlarging the playing surface.

The committee raised concerns regarding the area of responsibility between the Commissioners and the Department of Parks and Recreation in maintaining sports facilities throughout the municipalities. Mr. Dennis

Zermeno of the Department of Parks and Recreation told the Committee members that the Commissioners are capable of maintaining and doing minor repair of multipurpose courts in their villages. The Department can best serve the community by organizing and supervising recreational activities.

Recommendation

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources to which was referred Bill 226 (COR), AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATION FOR THE RESURFACING AND REPAIR OF THE PLAYING SURFACE, BACKBOARDS, BLEACHERS AND LIGHTING SYSTEM OF THE SANTA RITA BASKETBALL COURT, has had the same under consideration and recommends: **TO DO PASS AS SUBSTITUTED BY THE COMMITTEE ON YOUTH, SENIOR CITIZENS, CULTURAL AFFAIRS AND HUMAN RESOURCES.**

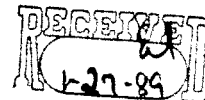

Good afternoon... Chairperson Arriola and members of the Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources. My name is Joseph Perez Claveria and I am currently a resident of Santa Rita village. I also serve as a member of the municipal planning council.

At the onset, I would like to thank the Chairperson for affording this opportunity to testify on Bill No. 226, an act making appropriation for the resurfacing and repair of the playing surface, backboards, bleachers and lighting system of the Santa Rita basketball court. I should note, however, that I am in deep support and favor of this bill. Now that this is in the making, Chairperson Arriola, it gives me great pride and confidence to say that finally the government is working. Working, that is, to remedy the profound structural problems of our dilapidated basketball court.

For all intents, given that there are several hundred youths and young adults in Santa Rita, there is only one court. This court has been inadequately maintained for several years past, and to a large extent, neglected. This is why I feel that Bill 226 is timely. Nonetheless, the present physical condition of the court warrants major work or what I call **FACELIFT**.

There are many benefits that this Bill, if enacted, will effect. First, organized village basketball can become a reality again. Secondly, village participation in island-wide basketball league can also be revived. The last but not least benefit that I deem of this Bill is that of a happier village community. Happier, I say, because the newly refurbished sports facility will be at their disposal. Incidentally, this court may be used for not only basketball, but volleyball and hockey too.

The Santa Rita basketball court is a facility that is in definite need of repair and upgrading. The court has a definite advantage in that it is located directly within the village, is adjacent to the Santa Rita ball field and is also adjacent to a restroom. All of these conditions make the Santa Rita recreational area one of centralized value.

It is important that the restoration of the multi-purpose court be complete. Patchwork and resurfacing will not do the job. It is important that the project include the creation of a one percent slope on the new court surface, the installation of new fencing where needed, and increased playing surface and modification of the lighting system.


Recreational facility repair funds, if allocated and planned properly, is definitely a wise investment. However I must repeat, the planning must be proper.

Bill No. 226 is a good bill for the upgrading of a functional facility that will play an important part in the further use of the Santa Rita recreational area.

The administration supports this kind of legislation. It is important at this time to look at additional recreational facilities that meet the same use and have them upgraded.

I therefore urge passing of Bill No. 226.




