1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 2 Section 1. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Power Authority to relocate power poles 3 and power lines on the Balajadia Road in Yona, and One Hundred Fifty 4 5 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) are appropriated to the Public Utility Agency of Guam to install a six-inch (6") water line with fire hydrants on said 6 7 road.

RECOPIED AT GOVERNMENT EXPENSE

Section 2. The Yona Municipal Council shall oversee the power pole and power lines relocation and water line project authorized by this Act and shall coordinate with the Guam Power Authority and the Public Utility Agency of Guam with its implementation. The contracting officers for the project shall be the General Manager of the Guam Power Authority and the Chief Officer of the Public Utility Agency of Guam, respectively.

REPRODUCED AT GOVERNMENT EXPENSE

Section 3. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Power Authority to install lighting at the Yona Baseball Field and streetlights in the following areas in Yona:

### COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS REPORT ON BILL NO. 374

BILL NO. 374: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE RELOCATION OF POWER LINES AND INSTALLATION OF A 6" INCH WATER LINE WITH FIRE HYDRANT ON BALAJADIA ROAD IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF YONA."

A joint public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations on Friday, May 5, 1989, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 374. Committee Chairs, Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez and Senator Ted S. Nelson respectively, were joined by Senators Martha C. Ruth, Franklin J.A. Quitugua, Doris F. Brooks and J. George Bamba.

#### BACKGROUND

Bill No. 374 would appropriate \$250,000 from the General Fund to the Yona Commissioner's Office for relocation of power lines and installation of a 6" water line.

#### TESTIMONY

Mr. Vicente C. Bernardo, Commissioner of Yona, appearing at the hearing on behalf of the Municipal Planning Council and the residents of Yona, presented an oral testimony in full support and urged the passage of Bill No. 374. Commissioner Bernardo submitted a copy of the cost breakdown (see Exhibit A).

Mr. Anthony C. Blaz, Chief Officer, Public Utility Agency of Guam, appearing at the hearing submitted a written testimony in full support (see Exhibit B). Mr. Blaz stated in his testimony that the "area is currently being service by 2" water lines and residents are frequently suffering from low water pressure. As a result, lives and properties are being exposed to constant danger from inadequate water and lack of fire hydrants for fire protection. PUAG encourages passage of Bill No. 374, specifically that portion relating to water system improvement in Balajadia Road."

#### ANALYSIS

The appropriation of \$250,000 will be sufficient for the relocation of Power lines and installation of a 6 inch water line with fire hydrant on Balajadia Road in Yona.

#### RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations recommends that Bill No. 375 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.

Good morning, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislative Committee on Ways & Means. I am here today to testify in support of Bill 374(COR) - An Act to Appropriate the Sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars for the Relocation of Power Lines and Installation of a 6° Inch Water Line with Fire Hydrant on Balajadia Road in the Municipality of Yona.

Specifically, the Public Utility Agency is in full support of funding for the installation of water line and fire hydrants on Balajadia road in Yona. This area is currently being serviced by 2° water lines and residents are frequently suffering from low water pressure. As a result, lives and properties are being exposed to constant danger from inadequate water and lack of fire hydrants for fire protection.

Relating to the above, I would like to take this opportunity to encourage members of this committee to introduce other legislation to fund similar projects throughout the island where water service problems occur. In addition, we must not forget that along with financing water systems improvements, we must make best use of our investment dollars through efficient operations and maintenance (O & M) of new facilities. In order to do so, continuous funding will need to be in place.

Again, PUAG encourages your passage of Bill 374(COR); specifically that portion relating to water system improvement in Balajadia Road, Yona. Thank you for the opportunity to testify.







#### COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 374(COR)

Bill 374(COR) appropriates the sum of \$250,000 from the General Fund to the Yona Commissioner's Office for power pole relocation and the installation of a 6-inch water line to include a fire hydrant on Balajadia Road, Municipality of Yona. The Commissioner of Yona shall oversee and coordinate the two projects with the Public Utility Agency of Guam and the Guam Power Authority.

The Bureau is unable to comment on whether the appropriation amount will be adequate to complete the proposed projects at this time as both PUAG and GPA are currently conducting its onsite review and assessing the projects requirements. Both agencies are unable to give a final determination on the cost estimates for the projects.
