AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE MILLION DOLLARS TO EXTEND SEWER LINES IN YONA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Legislative finding. The Legislature finds that since there are no sewer lines in the As Namo area in Yona, or at the entrance to M. U. Lujan School or in the Yona Supermarket area, extremely unsanitary conditions arise in these places in Yona during the island's lengthy rainy season.

Section 2. Appropriation. One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam to construct sewer lines in the As Namo area and from the entrance of M. U. Lujan School to the Yona Supermarket, all in the Municipality of Yona.

Section 3. Coordination. The Public Utility Agency of Guam shall oversee the sewer lines project and shall coordinate with the Commissioner of Yona and other appropriate government agencies in its implementation.

COMMITTEE ON WAYS & MEANS REPORT ON BILL NO. 378

BILL NO. 378: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE EXTENSION OF SEWER LINES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF YONA."

A joint public hearing was conducted by the Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations on Friday, May 5, 1989, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimony on Bill No. 378. Committee Chairs, Senator Carl T.C. Gutierrez and Senator Ted S. Nelson respectively, were joined by Senators Martha C. Ruth, Franklin J.A. Quitugua, Doris F. Brooks, and J. George M. Bamba.

BACKGROUND

Bill No. 378 would appropriate \$1,000,000 from the General Fund to Public Utility Agency of Guam to construct sewer lines in the As Namo area and from the entrance of M. U. Lujan School to the Yona Supermarket.

TESTIMONY

Mr. Vicente C. Bernardo, Commissioner of Yona appeared at the hearing on behalf of the Municipal Planning Council and the residents of Yona, presented oral testimony in support and urged the passage of Bill No. 378.

Mr. Anthony C. Blaz, Chief Officer, Public Utility Agency of Guam submitted written testimony supporting the Bill (see Exhibit A) and other bills that would provide financing for water and wastewater infrastructure improvements to better serve our residents. Mr. Blaz strongly suggest that Section 3 of the bill be amended so that Public Utility Agency of Guam oversee the project and coordinate with the Commissioner of Yona in the implementation of this project.

ANALYSIS

The appropriation of \$1,000,000 will be sufficient to accommodate design and construction of sewer lines as proposed. The Fiscal Note is attached (see Exhibit B).

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways & Means and the Committee on General Governmental Operations recommends that Bill No. 378 be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature as Amended.

TESTIMONY ON BILL 378 (COR)

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE EXTENSION OF SEWER LINES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF YONA

Submitted by Anthony C. Blaz, Chief Officer Public Utility Agency of Guam May 5, 1989

Good morning, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislative Committee on Ways & Means. I am here today to testify on Bill 378(COR) - An Act to Appropriate the Sum of One Million Dollars from the General Fund for the Extension of Sewer Lines in the Municipality of Yona.

PUAG fully supports this and other bills that would provide financing for water and wastewater infrastructure improvements to better serve our residents.

Considering the Muncipality of Yona is a potentially high growth area in Central Guam, we must provide adequate wastewater infrastructure to not only accommodate existing residences, but also future developments in the area. By doing so, we will ensure that the health of the people and environment of the area are protected through the proper disposal of sewage.

This bill specifically calls for the construction of sewer lines in the As Namo area from the entrance of M.U. Lujan School to the Yona Supermarket. Due to lack of public sewer collection system, area residents are presently using septic tank-leachfield method of sewage disposal. During rainy season,

unsanitary condition occassionally occurs due to old age and inefficiency of these individual septic systems.

Section 3 of Bill 378(COR) stated that:

"The Commissioner of Yona shall oversee the sewer lines project and shall work together with the Department of Public Works in the implementation of this project."

We strongly suggest that this section be changed to read:

"The Public Utility Agency of Guam shall oversee the sewer lines project and shall coordinate with the Commissioner of Yona and other appropriate government agencies in the implementation of this project."

Although we feel that the Commissioner of Yona is capable of overseeing the project; however, he may not have the necessary staff support or expertise to ensure that these sewer lines are properly constructed and in compliance with PUAG and EPA requirements for sewage collection system. We also feel that the implementation of this project should not directly involve the Department of Public Works (DPW) since:

- 1. PUAG has been given a Delegation of Authority from DPW to administer all water and wastewater construction contracts; and
- PUAG is the agency responsible to oversee all sewage collection, treatment and disposal activities.

Therefore, PUAG should be responsible for the implementation of this project,

and will coordinate with DPW relative to highway crossing and other related activities which may occur on public roads during construction.

With the suggested changes mentioned above, PUAG encourages your passage of this legislation. The passage of this bill will not only improve the health and environmental conditions of the project area, but will also generate additional revenue for PUAG through billing and collection of sewer services.
