




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (c) OF §80103 OF TITLE
10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, ON THE PROCUREMENT OF
SPECIALIZED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES BY
THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. Subsection (c) of §80103 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated,
3 is amended to read:

1 "(c) Acquire, subject to the laws of Guam, by grant,
2 purchase, gift, devise or lease, and hold and use any real property
3 necessary or convenient or useful for the carrying on of any of its
4 powers pursuant to the provisions of this Article; upon written
5 certification of the Administrator, countersigned by the Chairman
6 of the Board, that specified and specialized medical equipment
7 and related supplies are needed immediately for the health and
8 welfare of the patients of the Hospital in particular, and the
9 people of Guam in general, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority
10 shall be exempt from the provisions of §§5210 and 5211 of Title
11 5, Guam Code Annotated, in the acquisition of the medical
12 equipment and related supplies specified in such written
13 certification of the Administrator; provided, that the Hospital shall
14 use its best judgment and efforts to secure the best equipment
15 and supplies at the lowest cost, utilizing businesses licensed to do
16 business on Guam whenever possible;"

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROCUREMENT OF SPECIFIED AND
SPECIALIZED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES BY
THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 21 of Public Law 16-124 is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 21. Subsection (c) of §49003 of the Government Code is amended to read:

"(c) Acquire, subject to the laws of the territory of Guam, by grant, purchase, gift, devise or lease, and hold and use any real property necessary or convenient or useful for the carrying on of any of its powers pursuant to the provisions of this Chapter. Upon written certification of the Administrator of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, countersigned by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, that specified and specialized medical equipment and supplies are needed immediately for the health and welfare of the patients of Guam Memorial Hospital in particular, and the people of the Territory of Guam in general, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority shall be exempted from the the provisions of Sections 6959, 6959.1 and 6959.2 of Article B, Chapter 3 of Public Law 16.124 as to applicable to the medical equipment and supplies specified in said written certification in order to effect the most expeditious procurement and acquisition of said specified and specialized medical equipment and supplies. The Guam Memorial Hospital shall use its best judgement and efforts to secure the best equipment and supplies at the best cost, utilizing businesses licensed to do business on Guam whenever possible."
