PREFACE

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources held a public hearing in the Legislative Session Hall on October 23, 1989, to receive testimony on **Bill No. 696**. The hearing was conducted by Committee Chairperson, Senator Elizabeth P. Arriola and attended by Senators Frank R. Santos, Pilar C. Lujan, Eddie D. Reyes, Edward R. Duenas, Thomas V. C. Tanaka and Martha C. Ruth.

TESTIMONY

Mr. Francisco N. Lizama, Mayor of the Municipality of Sinajana, testified in support of the passage of Bill No. 696. He told the Committee that since the tennis court and baseball field were built, they have never been repaired to prevent them from deteriorating by their constant usage.

Mayor Lizama and Vice Mayor Danny Sablan recommended that the bill should also include other renovation and repair projects such as the resurfacing and improvements of the multipurpose court, Children Playground court and Mini Park. The Mayor indicated that the amount of Bill No. 696 is sufficient to cover the other projects.

Mr. Tony Mariano, Director, Department of Parks and Recreation, submitted written testimony in support of Bill No. 696.

There being no further testimony on Bill No. 696, the Chairperson adjourned the hearing on Bill No. 696.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources, to which was referred *Bill No. 696, "AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE RENOVATION AND REPAIR OF THE SINAJANA TENNIS COURT AND BASEBALL FIELD"*, has had the same under consideration, and now wishes to report back the same with the recommendation **TO DO PASS** as substituted.







Please note that we are requesting that Bill No. 696 be amended to include funding for the repair and renovation of the Sinajana Multi Purpose Court. We point out that funds were appropriated by the Nineteenth Guam Legislature for work on the multi purpose court but the work has never been initiated. Because of this, we are asking that the multi purpose court be included in Bill No. 696 to insure that the work is accomplished.

We would also point out that the most expeditious passage and enactment of this legislation would permit the work to be performed and finished prior to the summer break of the schools. This would be most advantageous as the heaviest utilization of the facilities are during the summer months by students on their summer vacation.

Madam Chairperson and Honorable Members of the Committee on
Youth, Senior Citizens, Cultural Affairs and Human Resources:

We, the Mayor and Vice Mayor of the Municipality of Sinajana,
are here today to submit testimony in favor of the passage of
Bill No. 696, AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE RENOVATION
AND REPAIR OF THE SINAJANA TENNIS COURT AND BASEBALL FIELD.

Since the subject facilities were built they have never
been repaired or maintained in such fashions as would prevent
the gradual deterioration brought about by the years and constant
usage. An inspection of the facilities will verify the need
for the work prescribed in Bill No. 696.


Relative to utilization, I should point out that the
facilities in Sinajana are constantly being used. On any given
day, residents of Sinajana, as well as, citizens from other
vil_lages, can be seen and found utilizing these facilities to
their enjoyment, as well as, physical health. Though we have


never conducted a survey to determine the degree of utilization or the number of individuals enjoying the facilities, it would not be difficult to obtain statements to that effect. Because of this fact, the renovation and repair of these facilities would not only be beneficial to the residents of Sinajana but to any individual wishing to utilize them.

On a related subject, we are requesting this Committee to amend the proposed legislation to include the repair and renovation of the Sinajana Multi-Purpose Court. This facility, used for basketball, volleyball and hockey games, is also heavily used by residents of Sinajana, as well as, individuals from other villages. Again, as with the other facilities, the multi-purpose court has never been repaired or maintained to the degree necessary to accomodate the heavy utilization. This lack of repair and maintenance has been the case since the opening of the facility.

As the two individuals elected by the people of Sinajana to oversee the operational capabilities of the facilities in that village, we are requesting that this legislation be amended as noted above and expeditiously passed by the Guam Legislature as there are plans for increased utilization of the facilities by organized groups of youth participating in sports functions. As the Committee with oversight on Youth activities, we are confident that each member of the Committee is cognizant and desirous of facilities that are most accomodating to these youth activities, are adequate for the intended uses and are safe for all participants, be they in organized groups or individually.

We thank this Committee for its attention to the needs of the residents of Sinajana and we especially wish to extend a sincere Si Yu'os Ma'ase to the Committee's Chairperson for sponsoring and introducing the legislation. Rest assured that you will continue to have our support for programs and efforts designed to promote and enhance desirable activities for the residents of all villages on Guam.
