



An act relative to amending the Title of Commissioner to Mayor.

(Introduced by Senator Madeleine Z. Bordallo)

PREFACE

The Committee on General Governmental Operations, to which was referred Bill No. 120, "An act relative to amending the title of Commissioner to Mayor," conducted a public hearing on Monday, June 12, 1989, at 9:30 a.m. in the Legislative Session Hall. [Attachment 2]

Committee members present were Senator Ted S. Nelson, Chairman, and Senator Tommy V.C. Tanaka. Committee members not present were excused by the Chairman. [Attachment 3]

NOTIFICATION

Letters of notification were sent to the Governor, the Director of Administration, the Attorney General, the Director of Bureau of Budget and Management Research, to all Commissioners and Assistant Commissioners, and to the Committee members. [Attachment 4]

TESTIMONIES

The President of the Commissioner's Council, Mr. Raymond S. Laguana, was first to testify. He commended the Chairman for conducting a public hearing on Bill No. 120. and urged that the legislation be reported out favorably by the Committee with the recommendation to do pass. Furthermore, Mr. Laguana stated that the passage of Bill 120 will definitely pave the way for recognizing the importance of the Commissioners and their role in the various municipalities.

Mr. Nito Blas, Commissioner of Mangilao, testified that changing the name from "Commissioner" to "Mayor" is tantamount to giving the commissioners a promotion. This amendment, said Commissioner Blas, will definitely set us aside from the other commissioners in the Government of Guam. He elaborated saying that aside from the elected commissioners, there are other commissioners appointed by the Governor who serve on various boards and commissions.

Commissioner Frank Portusach testified that the change in title will bring the status of the Commissioners up to par with the mayorial system in the mainland. "With this, we can now write and attend the annual Mayors' conference," said Mr. Portusach.

Mrs. Teresita B. Castro, Assistant Commissioner from Tamuning-Tumon, testified that although this is her first appearance, she supports the name change and that she shares the same sentiment as the Commissioner of Tamuning-Tumon.

At this time, Senator Ted S. Nelson asked the Commissioners present whether the Council explored the possibility of amending the existing statutes governing the commissioners. Commissioner Laguana replied that the Council will be submitting to the Committee a comprehensive package suggesting amendments to the existing law pertaining to commissioners.

Before recognizing the presence of a Committee member, the Chairman acknowledged the presence of Mrs. Isabel Haggard, Commissioner of Piti, and Mr. Vicente L. San Nicolas, Commissioner of Asan-Maina. Commissioner Haggard expressed her support for the name change, but querried whether the Legislature will be amending the composition of the Commissioner once the mayor bill is enacted into law. She was assured by the Chairman that the Committee has no intentions of reducing the number of Commissioners. Commissioner San Nicolas also echoed the same sentiment.

Mr. Greg M. Borja, Commissioner of Santa Rita, presented written testimony [Attachment 5] and also testified orally that he also supports the name change.

The Chairman, noting that the bill only made reference to the Commissioners, inquired whether the Council has decided on a name for the Assistant Commissioners. Commissioner Laguana responded that the Council agrees that the assistants should be called "Deputy Mayors."

Senator Tommy V.C. Tanaka was then recognized by the Chairman. At the outset, he querried the Commissioners if they wanted Bill 120 amended to reflect not only the name change but also adding the adding responsibilities that come with the position. Commissioner Laguana responded that while he appreciates the intent of Senator Tanaka, he suggests that Bill 120 be passed in its present form, and that a more substantive bill addressing the concerns of the Commissioners be dealt with at a later date. Commissioner Laguana stated that "we are prepared to submit to the Committee the suggested amendments to strengthen the duties and responsibilities of the Commissioners. He added that "this must be done right and that we must not get greedy ... we'll take it one step at a time."

There being no further questions, the Chairman then adjourned the hearing on Bill No. 120.

FINDINGS

The Committee on General Governmental Operations, to which was referred Bill No. 120, finds that:

- 1. The commissionership system in Guam has undergone many changes over the years, but one thing remains clear. No matter what the Commissioners have been named or called in the past, village government has provided the strongest and most significant part of the foundation of self-government in Guam.
- 2. From the early beginnings, we have seen numerous changes in representative self-government in Guam. When the Americans occupied Guam in 1898, the Commissioner system was expanded but still the Naval Governor held the power.
- 3. On February 3, 1917, the First Guam Congress was convened. For almost 30 years after that, through the 2nd Guam Congress of 1931, many experiments were conducted. They all lead to greater self-government.
- 4. Throughout Guam's history, the Commissioners maintained that control was needed at the village level. They were the best informed as to what the people's real needs were. They were, to this day, sought out by all elected officials to obtain information about the true feelings of the respective municipality.
- 5. Through the enactment of Public Law 14-27, the Commissioners were given more defined authority and responsibilities, a Municipal Planning Council was created, and a Municipal Fund was established. With this law, the Commissioners can now more and more interpret the specific desires of their respective community.
- 6. The Committee further finds that Bill No. 120 be passed to reflect the growth of the municipal government.

SECTION ANALYSIS

A section analysis of Bill No. 120, as substituted by the Committee, is attached and titled "Profile on Bill No. 120."

RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on General Governmental Operations, to which was referred Bill No. 120, "An act to amend Sections 15000 et seq. of Title XVI of the Government Code, to amend Section 16204 (1) and (2) of Chapter 16, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated and other provisions of law making reference to Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner, to change the name of Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner to Mayor and Deputy Mayor," has had the same under consideration and now wishes to report the same with the recommendation to do pass as substituted [Attachment 6] by the Committee.

These sections make reference to the elected position of Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner and changes the name to Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

The only significant thing accomplished by enacting Substitute Bill No. 120 is that it changes the name of Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner to Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

Guam village commissioners may be referred to as mayors in the future, if the Legislature grants their request.

The commissioners in a special meeting Wednesday unanimously approved a motion requesting the Legislature to consider changing the title of Guam village commissioners to mayors.

"This is to follow the system and titles used in the United States," Barrigada Commissioner Raymond Laguana, council president, said.

"We are at a local level government similar to those of mayors in the United States so we should have uniform titles. It would give dignitiy to these positions," he said.

Laguana said, "Right now there are too many boards, commisssions and similar entities which make it very confusing for the public in their dealings with commissioners."

Other items discussed in Wednesdays' meeting include stray dogs, the \$52 million infrastructure bond issue and the summer youth program.
