- BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to fund the following projects in the Municipality of Inarajan:
 - (a) One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to provide a new multi-purpose court complete with lighting facilities; and
 - (b) One Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$180,000) to construct a baseball field.

Section 2. The Inarajan Municipal Planning Council shall coordinate the projects authorized by Section 1 of this Act with the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Department of Public Works. The contracting officer for the project shall be the Director of Public Works.

Section 3. This Act may be cited as "The Inarajan Recreational Facilities Act of 1989".

PREFACE:

The Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Bill No. 825, "An act to appropriate funds for improvements and construction of recreational facilities in the Municipality of Inarajan," conducted a public hearing on Tuesday, July 25, 1989 at 10:00 a.m. in the Legislative Session Hall. [Attachment 2]

Committee members present were Senator Ted S. Nelson, Acting Chairman, Committee on Ways and Means. Also present were Senators John P. Aguon, Elizabeth P. Arriola, Pilar C. Lujan, Doris F. Brooks, Martha C. Ruth, Tommy V.C. Tanaka and Ernesto Espaldon.

NOTIFICATION:

Letters of notification [Attachment 3] were sent to: the Governor; the Director, Bureau of Budget and Management Research; to the Director, Department of Public Works; the President, Commissioners Council; to the Commissioner of Inarajan; the Committee members and to the general public, and the newsmedia.

TESTIMONY:

In written testimony submitted to the Committee, the Commissioner of Inarajan, informed the Committee that the facilities outlined in the legislation are essential and crucial elements for youth development in his municipality. The Commissioner went on to say that the lack of facilities in his municipality negates the development of sports activities for the youth. According to the Commissioner, bringing these facilities to his community will render enormous impact on youth needs and development.

A CLOSER LOOK

Section 1. Appropriates Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000) from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to fund the following projects in Inarajan:

- (a) \$150,000 shall be used for the purpose of providing a new multi-purpose court complete with lighting facilities; and
- (b) \$180,000 shall be used for the construction of a baseball field.

Section 2. Provides that the Municipal Council coordinate the projects with the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Department of Public Works regarding the implementation of the two projects. It further provides that the Director of Public Works shall be the contracting officer for the projects.

Section 3. Cites or makes reference to the Act as "The Inarajan Recreational Facilities Act of 1989."

There being no further testimonies, the Chairman of the Committee adjourned the hearing on Bill No. 825.

SECTION ANALYSIS:

COMMITTEE FINDINGS:

The Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred Bill No. 825, finds that:

- 1. There exists a need for a multi-purpose court complete with light-ing facilities.
- 2. In addition to completing the multi-purpose court, the Committee also finds that there exists a need to construct a baseball field to accommodate the needs of the growing youth population in Inarajan.
- 3. The Committee finds that the total amount needed to complete these two projects amount to \$330,000
- 4. The Committee on Ways and Means recommends that the Legislature act favorably on Substitute Bill No. 825.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:
