Transmitted herewith is Bill No. 636, which I have signed into law this date as Public Law No. 20-53.



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO PROVIDE IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDING A SAFE WALKWAY, PLAYGROUND AND CANOPIES FOR ORDOT-CHALAN PAGO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AGUEDA JOHNSTON MIDDLE SCHOOL, AND F.Q. SANCHEZ AND TRUMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 2 Section 1. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are appropriated 3 from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to provide 4 sidewalks from Route 4 to the Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary School and to 5 the Agueda Johnston Middle School.

1 Section 2. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to grade, back-fill 2 and landscape the rear playground of Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary School. Section 3. Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) are appropriated from the

General Fund to the Department of Public Works to erect a canopy leading 5 from the unloading area at the entrance of Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary 6 School to the first building of the school. 7

8 Section 4. One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) are appropriated 9 from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to construct a 10 canopy for F. Q. Sanchez Elementary School.

11 Section 5. Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) are appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works to construct a 12 13 walkway and canopy at Truman Elementary School connecting the 14 kindergarten classrooms to the main building.

15 Section 6. The Departments of Education and Public Works are 16 directed to work closely to coordinate the projects authorized in this Act so as to provide their expeditious construction. 17

Joint Public Hearing Committee on Education Committee on Ways and Means Committee Report Bill No. 636

The Committee on Education and the Committee on Ways and Means chaired by Chairman Franklin J.A. Quitugua conducted a public hearing on August 9, 1989 at 10:00 a.m. at the Legislative Session Hall to hear testimonies on Bill No. 636. Bill No. 636 is "An Act to Appropriate Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000) From the General Fund for FY'89 to Provide Safe Walkway for Ordot-Chalan Pago and Agueda Johnston Middle School and Other Purposes". In attendance were Senators George Bamba, Martha Ruth, Ernesto Espaldon, and Antonio Unpingco. Appearing before the committee to testify were former Speaker Florenzo Ramirez, Chalan Pago Commissioner Ben San Nicolas, Umatac Commissioner Albert Topasna, Santa Rita Commissioner Greg M. Borja, Department of Education Director Anita Sukola, and Guam Federation of Teachers Lon Bottcher.

DOE Director Anita Sukola submitted written testimony in support of Bill 636 (See Exhibit A). Her testimony emphasized the need for sidewalks to be used by the elementary student providing safety and security and for a much needed playground.

Mrs. Jeanette R. Yamashita, Associate Superintendent, DOE submitted written testimony in support of the bill. (See Exhibit B.)

Former Speaker Ramirez explained that the school was first built in 1967. As a nearby resident, he has observed through the years students walking in the streets and avoiding the traffic in the 25 feet road. He has also witnessed many opportunities for traffic mishap. He was pleased to see this bill and requested the Senators to act on this matter before any serious accidents occur.

Commissioner San Nicolas also testified of the student movement on the streets there. He felt that such bill will definitely improve the conditions at the schools as well as the need for the canopy and playground for the students to enjoy.

Commissioner Topasna offered his support to his colleague and added that the Senators also include a canopy for Umatac's F.Q. Sanchez Elementary School. The Senators agreed to support his request and to include \$100,000 appropriation for Umatac.

Commissioner Greg M. Borja also offered his support and requested for a walkway canopy for Truman Elementary Kindergarten classrooms to the main building. The Senators present agreed to provide \$75,000 appropriation to Truman Elementary.

Mr. Botcher was pleased to see the senators include the needs for the other schools and thanked them for their support for Bill 636.

Mrs. Yamashita further added that as a former principal at Chalan Pago there was definitely a need to provide the appropriation to address the problem. She further added that she would like a provision in the law that will allow for prompt action of Public Works to pursue the workscope.

Committee Findings and Recommendations

The Committee finds that the appropriation measure will provide for the much needed sidewalk, canopy and playground for Ordot-Chalan Pago Elementary school. The schools are in dire need of canopies and safe walkways and sidewalks.

The Committee recommends that the bill be substituted to include appropriations to construct canopies for Truman Elementary, and F.O. Sanchez Elementary schools. The Committee reports favorable passage of Substitute Bill 636 and recommends support by the entire legislature.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund 3 for FY189 One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the Department 4 of Public Works to construct a canopy for F.Q. Sanchez Elementary School. 5 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund 6 for FY189 Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to the Department 7 of Public Works to construct a walkway and canopy at Truman Elementary 8 School connecting the Kindergarten classrooms to the main building. 9 10 Section 6. The Department of Education and Public Works will

work closely to coordinate the necessary logistical work that will provide for an expedient construction of canopies, sidewalks and playground at the schools affected by this Act.

Dear Mr. Chairman:

Thank you for allowing me the opportunity to testify on Bill No. 636 which proposes to provide \$550,000 for various capital improvement needs of the Ordot/Chalan Pago Elementary School an Agueda Johnston Middle School.

The Department of Education highly supports measures that would result in making schools safer, as this bill would allow. Currently students at these schools are forced to walk on the shoulders of the road fronting the schools, posing a danger to them due to heavy traffic. This bill proposes to provide sidewalks from the entrance of Route 4 to the schools, thereby allowing for greater safety to the students.

This measure also provides for upgrading the rear playground of the Ordot/Chalan Pago Elementary School and for erecting a canopy at the school.

Again, the Department of Education, which in recent years has embarked on an aggressive capital improvement effort at all public schools, supports measures that would enhance the physical environment of educational facilities for the greater safety and betterment of our students. Our students deserve no less.

I would like to commend the author of this measure, Senator Franklin J. Quitugua, for addressing yet another item on our Department's long list of capital improvement needs of our island's schools. Dear Senator Quitugua:

Thank You for the opportunity to provide input on Bill 636.

Section 1

The intent of Bill 636 is very commendable. Providing sidewalks from the entrance of Route 4 to the Ordot/Chalan Pago Elementary School will provide some street safety for the elementary students who must walk from their residence to the school. Presently the students are walking on the shoulder of the road. On rainy days when the shoulder of the road is muddy and wet, the students walk on the road. Of course, that practice endangers the lives of the student.

Section 2

As a former principal of Ordot/Chalan Pago Elementary, I am delighted that this problem will finally be financially addressed. During my tenure, the Army Reserve attempted to grade, back fill and landscape the rear playground. The Army Reserve gave up on assisting us with the project when their bulldozers got stuck in the clay soil for three (3) months.

The students of Ordot/Chalan Pago Elementary School have long been deprived of a proper playground. The alternate solution for a playgound these past years has been to use the school parking which has to be closed to the public during recess and lunch time. Not having proper facilities also deprived the students from having playground equipment which other schools have. Letter to Senator Quitugua Page 2

Section 3

Attempts had been made in the past to erect a canopy. Through the efforts of the school, Guam Community College students made a blueprint for a tin and wood canopy; however, it appears that this Bill is addressing a concrete structure.

The canopy will provide the coverage from the rain as the students board or disembark from the bus.

In closing, may I suggest that if any of the projects should have left over money that it be used for repair and maintenance of that school and that it be written into law as such.




